COLOSSIANS 3:17, 23-24

THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

It is a very easy thing to look at our jobs or responsibilities as drudgery. The pressure, the expectations, the challenges, can all steal the joy from what we are doing. Add to that the people we encounter. Not all of them are exactly delightful. People complain, they fuss, and they want their way. How are we to work in such an environment while maintaining our testimony?

Paul gives us a little help in Colossians 3. He tells us to remember that we do not work for another person. Sure, you may have a boss or supervisor, but ultimately your work is not for them. We are told that our work is to be done as “unto the Lord.” Yes, you may be my boss, but you are not the one for whom I work.

In reality, God has called us to do everything we do to honor Him. It does not matter if we are just taking the kids to school, or loading a dish washer, or buying groceries; all of it is to honor Him. Let us make this our ambition: “And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him” (Col 3:17).

To help us remember this, we have set aside today to be “Frontline Sunday.” Each of us have a frontline. These are the places that we play, work, hangout, or just generally find ourselves. These are the places that God has strategically put us. It is in these places that we must think about doing all things unto the Lord.

Today, as we worship together, make it a point to pray about how God would have you impact your frontline. Can you image the difference we could make if every person in this Worship Center made it a point to live the life of a difference maker?
