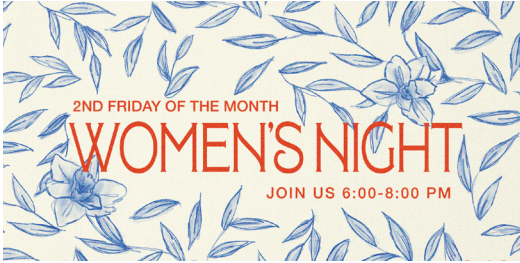

ROMANS 4:24

written for his sake alone,²⁴ but for ours also. It will be counted to us²⁵ who believe in²⁶ him who raised from the dead Jesus our Lord,²⁵ who was delivered up for our trespasses and raised²⁷ for our justification.

Peace with God Through Faith

¹Therefore, since we have been justified by faith,² we³ have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.³ Through him we have also⁴ obtained access by faith⁵ into this grace in which we stand, and⁶ we rejoice⁷ in hope in the glory of God.⁸ Not only that, but we⁹ rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering¹⁰ produces endurance,¹¹ and endurance produces character, and character produces hope,¹² and¹³ hope does not put us to shame because God's love¹⁴ has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.

¹⁵For¹⁶ while we were still weak, at the right time¹⁷ Christ died for the ungodly.¹⁸ For one who scarcely die for a righteous person—though perhaps for a good person one would da even to die—¹⁹but²⁰ God shows his love for us in that²¹ while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.²² Since, therefore,²³ we have now been justified by his blood, much more shall we be saved by him from²⁴ the wrath of God.²⁵ For²⁶ while we were enemies²⁷ we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved by²⁸ his life.²⁹ More than that, we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received³⁰ reconciliation.

³¹Therefore, just as³² sin came into the world through one man, and³³ death through sin, and³⁴ so death spread to all men³⁵ because³⁶ all sinned—³⁷ for sin indeed was in the world before the law was given, but³⁸ sin is

Paul systematically walks through the how, the why, and the what of our salvation. This is a book that you will find challenging at times, encouraging at times, and insightful at other times. I hope this study will be a blessing to you.

There are several things that I think will aide you as we walk through this book. First of all, I want to encourage you to read through the book of Romans several times during our study. As is the case with most books, the more time you spend in it, the more you will begin to connect the dots. So make a plan as to how you will approach it, but set a goal to read it through at least three times during our study of this book.

Second, take good notes. I know we provide the sermon outline for you in the bulletin, but this may be a time you want to grab an inexpensive journal somewhere and make your notes there. This will keep your notes all in one place and will help you as we review what we have learned.

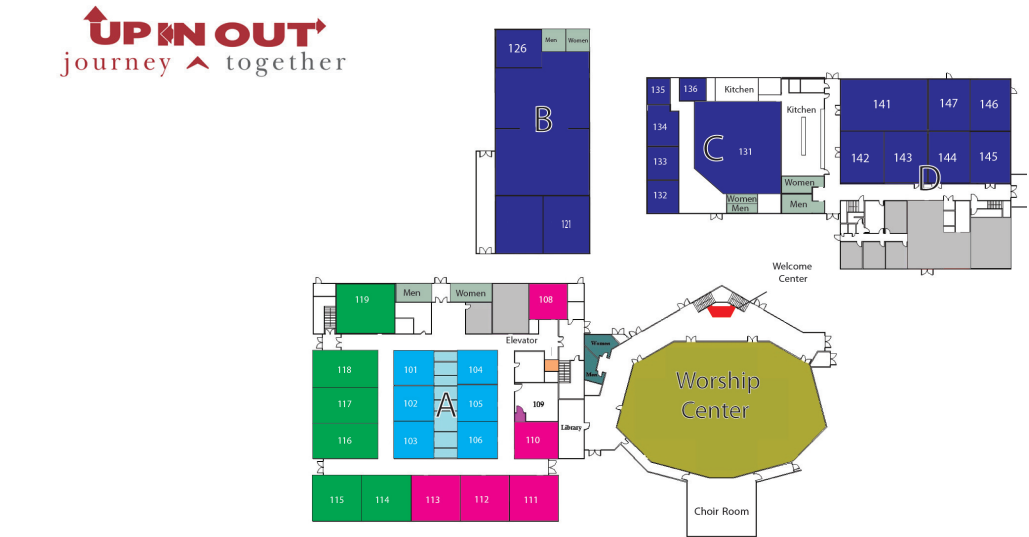

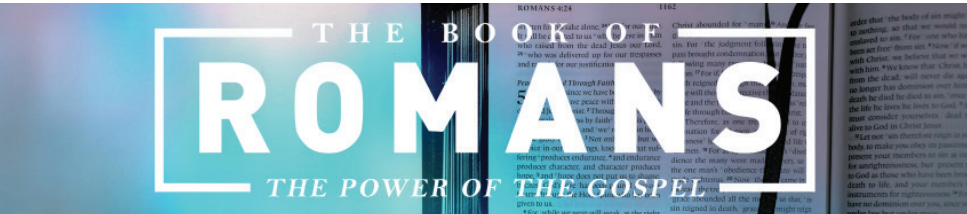
