THE POWER OF THE GOSPEL

ROMANS 4:24

written for his sake alone,²⁴ but for ours also. It will be counted to us²⁵ who believe in²⁶ him who raised from the dead Jesus our Lord,²⁵ who was delivered up for our trespasses and raised²⁷ for our justification.

Peace with God Through Faith

¹Therefore, since we have been justified by faith,² we will have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.³ Through him we have also obtained access by faith⁴ into this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice⁵ in hope of the glory of God.⁶ Not only that, but we also rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering⁷ produces endurance,⁸ and endurance produces character, and character produces hope,⁹ and¹⁰ hope does not put us to shame because God's love¹¹ has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.

¹²For while we were still weak, at the right time¹³ Christ died for the ungodly.¹⁴ For one who scarcely die for a righteous person—though perhaps for a good person one would dare even to die—¹⁵but¹⁶ God shows his love for us in that¹⁷ while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.¹⁸ Since, therefore, we have now been justified by his blood, much more shall we be saved by him from¹⁹ the wrath of God.²⁰ For while we were enemies²¹ we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved by²² his life.²³ More than that, we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received²⁴ reconciliation.

Death in Adam, Life in Christ

¹²Therefore, just as¹³ sin came into the world through one man, and¹⁴ death through sin, and¹⁵ so death spread to all men¹⁶ because¹⁷ all sinned—¹⁸ for sin indeed was in the world before the law was given, but¹⁹ sin is

THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

In Romans 1:16 Paul says, “For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.” It was this gospel that absolutely drove Paul. He felt it to be his life’s calling to take this gospel where he could, to proclaim it bodily to the masses.

When one considers what Paul walked away from, prior to the gospel, it is truly shocking. Paul was a Pharisee who was well accomplished. He checked all the boxes of what the Jewish people saw to be an ideal Jew. He had authority, he had money, and he had influence. He had committed his life to protecting the law of Moses. He had taken a number of Christians to jail and had given his consent to their deaths.

And then, Paul met Jesus Christ on the Damascus Road. In that encounter, everything changed for Paul. All his influence, all of his authority, all of his power, and even his earthly wealth no longer meant anything to him. He walked away from it all and never looked back. His life now became about spreading the gospel of Jesus Christ. He became one of the very people he used to persecute.

I want to ask you to consider for a moment this gospel. How is it that we, as Christians, have become so complacent as it relates to the gospel? Why do we not have the same sort of passion that Paul did? What will it take for us to shift our perspective? Is it possible that we might, at some small level, share the zeal Paul had? Paul had been deeply touched by the gospel and it changed everything. I pray that the gospel would impact us in the same way.

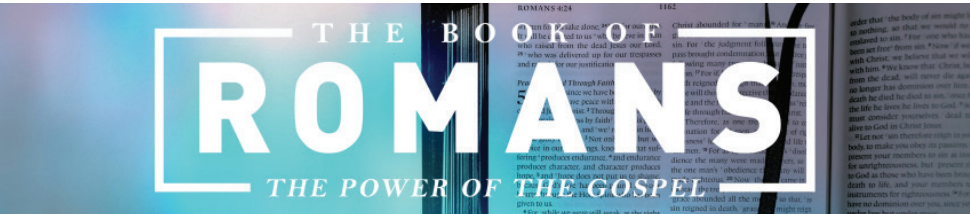

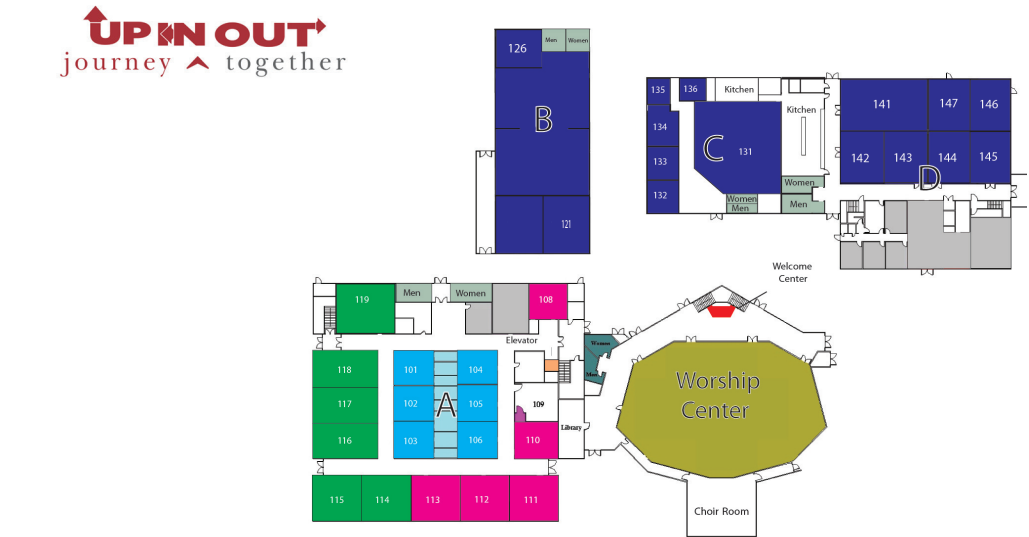
