written for his sake alone,²⁴ but for ours also. It will be counted to us "who believe in" him who raised from the dead Jesus our Lord,²⁵ who was delivered up for our trespasses and raised²⁶ for our justification.


Peace with God Through Faith

⁵To those who were enemies of God, he justified⁶ faith,⁷ we⁸ have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.⁹ Through him we have also¹⁰ obtained access¹¹ to God's grace¹² into this grace in which we stand, and we¹³ rejoice¹⁴ in hope¹⁵ of the glory of God.¹⁶ Not only that, but we¹⁷ rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering¹⁸ produces endurance,¹⁹ and endurance produces character,²⁰ and character produces hope,²¹ and²² hope does not put us to shame²³ because God's love²⁴ has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.

⁶For while we were still weak, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly.⁷ For one who scarcely died for a righteous person—though perhaps for a good person one would dare even to die—⁸ but God shows his love for us in that⁹ while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.¹⁰ Since, therefore,¹¹ we have now been justified by his blood, much more shall we be saved by him from¹² the wrath of God.¹³ For while we were enemies¹⁴ we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved by his life.¹⁵ More than that, we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received¹⁶ reconciliation.

Death in Adam, Life in Christ

¹²Therefore, just as sin came into the world through one man, and¹³ death through sin, and¹⁴ so death spread to all men¹⁵ because all sinned—¹⁶ for sin indeed was in the world before the law was given, but¹⁷ sin
