In Ephesians 4:11-12, Paul gives instructions as to the order and the function of the church. He says, "And he gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the shepherds and teachers to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for the building up of the body of Christ." Paul mentions either four or five offices of the church, depending on how you interpret this passage.

He says first of all that God gave us apostles. Those apostles were primarily the disciples that took on a new charge after the death, burial, and resurrection of Christ. Theirs was to pass on to us what Christ had taught them as well as the things God continued to reveal to them. It is my understanding that the office of apostle ceased with the death of the apostle John.

Next, he mentions prophets. In the Old Testament, we recognize these men as the authors of our major and minor prophets. We see a few others that are scattered about the Old Testament narrative. These men passed on the word of God as He revealed it to them. The last of these prophets would have been John the Baptist, who announced the ministry of Christ.

Paul also mentions evangelists. When we hear the term evangelists, we likely think of some man that rolls into town on Sunday, preaches hard for four days to a week, and then is gone again. However, when we see evangelist in the scripture, it is more likely that we are talking about what we would understand as a missionary. Someone who travels to a place for the specific purpose of sharing the gospel. It is my understanding that this calling continues to this day.

Finally, Paul speaks of the preachers/teachers. These are men who are called to care for the local body of believers. Their ministry will be multifaceted but really there is one main goal. The goal of all of these callings is to equip the church for the purpose of carrying out the ministry. Catch what is said, it is the people, not the hired guns, that are to do the work of the ministry.

In recent days, we have made a conscious effort to move the direction of the people owning the ministry. As part of that effort, we have empowered our committees to move forward with their various roles and responsibilities. With that, I want to give a word of caution: often, once the train starts moving, people want to jump on board. Not only do they want to jump on board, but often they try to steer the train. While we want our membership to engage (please engage and be a part), we must allow our committees to lead. Ambition is a great thing, but so is proper structure and order. If you have thoughts and ideas, relate those to the proper committee or to the pastoral staff and we will get them addressed.

Thank you all for your heart and desire to serve as part of the Northside team. I know that God will honor that and bless us as we move along. Let's just make sure that we are moving along in an orderly fashion.

PRAYER AND PRAISE




