written for his sake alone,²⁴ but for ours also. It will be counted to us "who believe in him who raised from the dead Jesus our Lord,²⁵ who was delivered up for our trespass and raised² for our justification.

Peace with God Through Faith

²⁴To reflect, since we have been justified by faith,^b we^a have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. Through him we have also^c obtained access^d to faith^e into this grace in which we stand, and we^f rejoice^g in hope of the glory of God. ²⁵Most surely that, but very rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering^h produces endurance. ⁴And endurance produces character, and character produces hope,⁵ and^h hope does not put us to shame because God's loveⁱ has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.

⁶For^j while we were still weak, at the right time^k Christ died for the ungodly.⁷ For one who scarcely die for a righteous person—though perhaps for a good person one would dare even to die—⁸but^l God shows his love for us in that^mwhile we were still sinners, Christ died for us.⁹ Since, therefore,ⁿ we have now been justified by his blood, much more shall we be saved by him from^o the wrath of God.¹⁰ For^p while we were enemies^q we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved by his life.¹¹ More than that, we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received^s reconciliation.

From time to time, you may ask your doctor a question and get an answer that you do not understand. Doctors tend to speak, well..., doctor. Because of their education and experience, they learn a language that almost does not sound like English. When you get one of these convoluted answers, you may have to ask the doctor to try again and put it in layman's terms. You may have to say, "Doc, explain that in a way that I can understand."

As we continue in our study of Romans, it is important for us to understand what is going on. This is Paul seeking to explain our salvation in a way that we can understand. Yes, it is wonderfully complex with all sorts of intricacies that may or may not be difficult to grasp. However, at its base level, our salvation can be understood by all.

In studying this book, do not become frustrated. Do not give in to the feeling that maybe it is too hard or too confusing to fully grasp. Stick with us. Continue to read. Continue to pray. Continue to ask God to make it clear to you. There is nothing that will evoke a greater sense of gratitude and worship than fully understanding what it is that God has done for us.


No believer should have a casual attitude toward his or her salvation. We were lost and dying in our transgressions and sins. We were at enmity (that is, we were enemies) with God. All the righteousness that we could possibly muster is an affront to Him. Yet, He saved us. When we were at our worst, God demonstrated His grace toward us by extending to us an offer of salvation.

So, what will our response be? Will it be an offensive attitude of casualness? Or, will we strive to fully understand what God has done for us and extend to Him our praise, worship, and gratitude? Let us find that place of humility and absolute shock that God would save a sinner, even a sinner like me.


