Sunday morning in church, I talked a little about the arrival of fall and cooler temperatures. Yes, I am aware that we do not experience drastic seasonal changes as people further north do (as I write this, it is currently 92°). Regardless, fall is here, and with it, subtle as they may be, a change in colors, some cooler temperatures, and an opportunity for reflection and gratitude. The Christmas season is the culmination of my favorite time of the year. It starts with that first September cool front (which is inevitably followed by weeks of 90's again), and grows gradually throughout the rest of the year.

As we see the changes around us, let us take a look inward and be honest with the Lord. Are there areas where He is calling us to change or grow?
