written for his sake alone,²⁴ but for ours also. It will be counted to us "who believe in him who raised from the dead Jesus our Lord,²⁵ who was delivered up for our trespass and raised² for our justification.

Peace with God Through Faith

^aTo refer, since we have been justified by faith,^b we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. ^cThrough him we have also "obtained access" to faith^d into this grace in which we stand, and we "rejoice" in hope of the glory of God. ^eIndeed that, but very often we "rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering^f produces endurance. ^gAnd endurance produces character, and character produces hope,^h and hope does not put us to shame because God's loveⁱ has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.

⁶For^j while we were still weak, at the right time^k Christ died for the ungodly.⁷ For one who scarcely die for a righteous person—though perhaps for a good person one would dare even to die—⁸but God shows his love for us in that^m while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.⁹ Since, therefore,ⁿ we have now been justified by his blood, much more shall we be saved by him from^o the wrath of God.¹⁰ For^p while we were enemies^q we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved by his life.^r More than that, we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received^s reconciliation.
