written for his sake alone,<sup>24</sup> but for ours all. It will be counted to us "who believe in him who raised from the dead Jesus our Lord,<sup>25</sup> who was delivered up for our trespass and raised<sup>2</sup> for our justification.

*Peace with God Through Faith*

<sup>24</sup>To refer, since we have been justified by faith,<sup>b</sup> we<sup>1</sup> have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. <sup>c</sup> Through him we have also "obtained access<sup>d</sup> to faith<sup>e</sup> into this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice<sup>f</sup> in hope of the glory of God. <sup>25</sup> Truly that, but we rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering<sup>g</sup> produces endurance.<sup>4</sup> And endurance produces character, and character produces hope,<sup>5</sup> and hope does not put us to shame, because God's love<sup>h</sup> has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.

<sup>6</sup> For<sup>i</sup> while we were still weak, at the right time<sup>k</sup> Christ died for the ungodly.<sup>7</sup> For one who scarcely die for a righteous person—though perhaps for a good person one would dare even to die—<sup>8</sup> but<sup>j</sup> God shows his love for us in that<sup>m</sup> while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.<sup>9</sup> Since, therefore,<sup>n</sup> we have now been justified by his blood, much more shall we be saved by him from<sup>o</sup> the wrath of God.<sup>10</sup> For<sup>p</sup> while we were enemies<sup>q</sup> we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved by his life.<sup>r</sup> More than that, we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received<sup>s</sup> reconciliation.



Simply put, Christ took the wrath for my sin and yours, and in return, offers us His righteousness.

While the news about our sinfulness is indeed bad, the good news is that Christ offers us what we could never earn on our own. We are told that through simply believing, we can have the righteousness of God. It is my prayer that you will know both what it means to believe and what it means to follow Christ. I pray that you will experience what it means to trade your unrighteousness for the righteousness of Christ.


