"And endurance produces character, and character produces hope, "and "hope does not put us to shame because God's love "has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.

"For one who scarcely die for a righteous person—though perhaps for a good person one would dare even to die—" "but "God shows his love for us in that "while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. "Since, therefore, "we have now been justified by his blood, much more shall we be saved by him from "the wrath of God. "For "while we were enemies "we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved by "his life. THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

One fact that rings true throughout scripture is that salvation is by faith, not by works (Eph. 2:8-9). Just as clearly as scripture makes this point, we also see people defaulting to

depend on their works. Paul takes this issue up in Philippians 3:4-6. He states, “If anyone else thinks he has reason for confidence in the flesh, I have more: circumcised on the eighth day, of the people of Israel, of the tribe of Benjamin, a Hebrew of Hebrews; as to the law, A Pharisee; as to zeal, a persecutor of the church; as to righteousness under the law, blameless.” If salvation was by works, Paul was a shoo-in.

However, scripture is clear. All our efforts cannot save us. We are saved by faith alone through grace alone. There are no other means by which we can be saved. Paul understood this and said in Philippians 3:7, “Whatever gain I had, I counted as loss of the sake of Christ.” Paul knew that all his efforts at righteousness would fall short.

I pray that we get this truth. No amount of rule keeping, no amount of effort, and no amount of trying will ever make us right with God. Our only hope is to recognize our own bankruptness (I know that’s not a word), and appeal to Christ for relief. If we fail to realize our inability to earn salvation, we leave ourselves in a dire situation.

Here is what it looks like...We must recognize that we are sinners. That is, we have fallen short of the holy standard of our God. We additionally must recognize that there is a price to pay for our sinfulness. Jesus paid that price on our behalf. So, we must make a decision to turn from our old life, repent of our sin, and follow Christ. This is the essence of what it means to be saved. Literally, we are saved from our sin and the consequences of our sin.

If you have not given up your own efforts to please God and earn His favor, please do so today. Turn to Him and plead for His salvation.

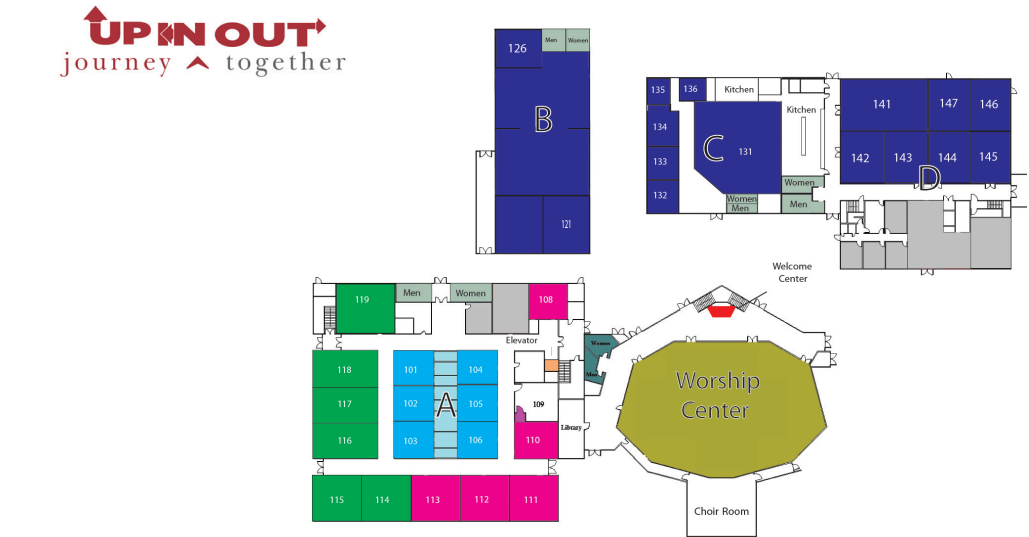
