written for his sake alone,²⁴ but for ours also. It will be counted to us²⁵ who believe in²⁶ him who raised from the dead Jesus our Lord,²⁵ who was delivered up for our trespasses and raised²⁷ for our justification.

Peace with God Through Faith

⁵To refer to, to be justified by faith,⁵ we⁶ have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.⁶ Through him we have also⁷ obtained access⁸ by faith⁹ into this grace in which we stand, and¹⁰ we rejoice¹¹ in hope in the glory of God.¹² Not only that, but we also rejoice¹³ in our sufferings, knowing that suffering¹⁴ produces endurance,¹⁵ and endurance¹⁶ produces character, and character produces hope,¹⁷ and¹⁸ hope does not put us to shame because God's love¹⁹ has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.

⁶For⁷ while we were still weak, at the right time⁸ Christ died for the ungodly.⁹ For one who scarcely die for a righteous person—though perhaps for a good person one would dare even to die—¹⁰but¹¹ God shows his love for us in that¹² while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.¹³ Since, therefore,¹⁴ we have now been justified by his blood, much more shall we be saved by him from¹⁵ the wrath of God.¹⁶ For¹⁷ while we were enemies¹⁸ we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved by¹⁹ his life.²⁰ More than that, we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received²¹ reconciliation.

Don't look now, but Thanksgiving is this week. When we really step back and look, even with all the craziness around us, we really do have a lot for which to be thankful.



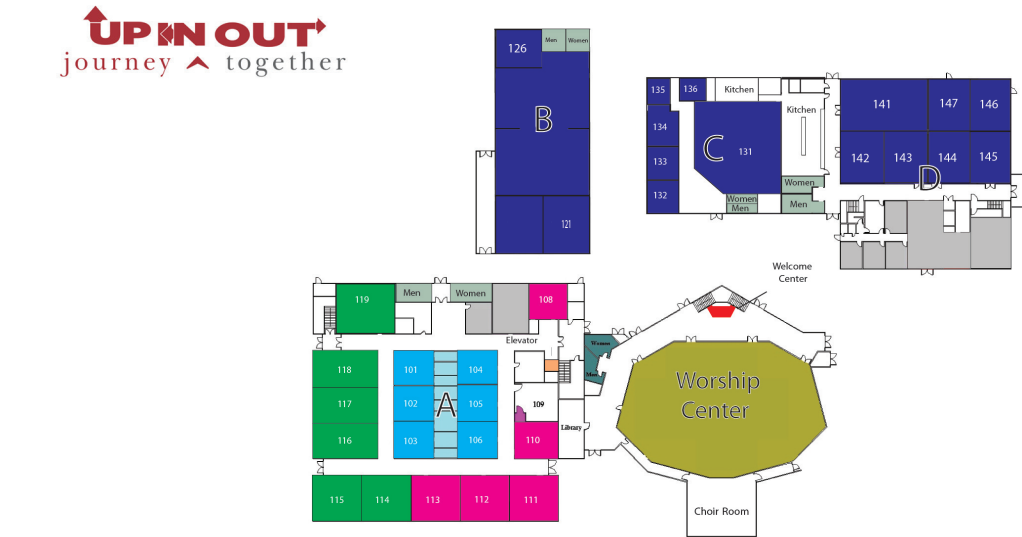
