written for his sake alone,²⁴ but for ours all. It will be counted to us "who believe in him who raised from the dead Jesus our Lord,²⁵ who was delivered up for our trespass and raised² for our justification.

Peace with God Through Faith

²⁴To refer, since we have been justified by faith,^b we¹ have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. ^c Through him we have also^b obtained access^d to the faith^e into this grace in which we stand, and we¹ rejoice^f in hope of the glory of God. ²⁵ Not only that, but very rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering^g produces endurance.⁴ And endurance produces character, and character produces hope,⁵ and^h hope does not put us to shame, because God's loveⁱ has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.

⁶ For^j while we were still weak, at the right time^k Christ died for the ungodly.⁷ For one who scarcely die for a righteous person—though perhaps for a good person one would dare even to die—⁸ but^j God shows his love for us in that^m while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.⁹ Since, therefore,ⁿ we have now been justified by his blood, much more shall we be saved by him from^o the wrath of God.¹⁰ For^p while we were enemies^q we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved by his life.^r More than that, we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received^s reconciliation.
