I love the second chapter of the gospel of Luke. It is one of those things that just puts me right in the spirit of Christmas. Hearing the words, “and there were in the same country shepherds abiding in the field...,” be it December or June, just takes me right to the gospel accounting of the birth of our Savior, and I love it!

This passage has always been my favorite part of the, A Charlie Brown Christmas Special. The show starts with Charlie confused because, even though

it was the holiday season, he is still not happy. Christmas cards, wrapping presents, decorating the tree... “I still end up feeling depressed.”. Linus tells him that “of all the Charlie Browns in the world, you’re the Charlie Browniest!”.

Charlie is the director of the school Christmas play and is tasked with finding a tree. Trying to manufacture the Christmas spirit, Charlie picks a runt tree that no one else would have chosen. He gets back and all of the kids ridicule his choice and tell him he can’t do anything right. Frustrated, he blurts out, “Isn’t there anyone who knows what Christmas is all about?!?”. Linus answers the call by quoting Luke 2:1-14, ending with “That’s what Christmas is all about, Charlie Brown.”.

One of the best parts of the show is what happens next. After Linus says this, Charlie looks at the little tree and a big smile comes across his face. He grabs the tree and walks home, the smile never leaving his face. The reading or hearing of God’s holy Word should always lift us up. Psalms 119 exclaims to God that His word “is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.”. It should also prompt us to action. Charlie was not the only one affected by Linus’ scripture reading. All of the kids had a change of heart about Charlie, as well as the tree. They follow him home and help decorate it, all with smiles on their faces.

So, when you hear this passage and any scripture, for that matter - let it soak in. Realize that it IS the Word and, as we learn in John’s gospel, Jesus IS the Word. And, respond. His Word always leaves us with an opportunity to respond - sometimes in action of serving others, sometimes to just sit in adoration of our Lord.

There are two opportunities this week to hear this Luke 2 passage - Darrell is hitting this chapter in his sermon series The Promised King, and we will experience it as part of the Worship Ministry program, His Name Shall Be - Sunday night at 6. Please come and be a part of it!
