WELCOME TO AWAKEN HOUSTON

Thank you for participating in Awaken Houston 2026, a unified season of prayer during Lent, taking place from February 16 through April 5. This year marks our 10th year of Awaken Houston, and we remain convinced that gospel movements are born at the intersection of unified, urgent prayer and bold gospel proclamation.

We believe God is inviting His Church in Houston to step into this movement together—seeking Him, listening for His voice, and trusting Him to work in ways beyond what we could ask or imagine.

2026 THEME:

WALKING WITH JESUS — LIGHT UP THE CITY

This year's theme, Walking with Jesus: Light Up the City, calls us to a simple yet powerful posture. This season is not about doing something impressive for God, but about taking faithful steps with Him. As we learn to walk with Jesus—day by day, street by street—we believe He will transform us, renew His Church, and bring awakening to our city.

PRAYER WALKING:

SATURATING OUR CITY WITH PRAYER

A key expression of walking with Jesus this season is prayer walking. Prayer walking is intercessory prayer that happens while walking in or near a specific place—your neighborhood, school, workplace, or city streets. As you prayer walk, your focus shifts beyond personal concerns to the needs of others, allowing God to shape your heart for your community.

Prayer walking invites us to:

- See people and places through God's eyes
- Listen to the Holy Spirit as we observe our surroundings
- Actively seek the peace and well-being of our city

This year, we are setting a bold goal as the Church in Houston: to collectively prayer walk **100,000 miles**, covering our neighborhoods and communities in prayer.

USING THIS PRAYER GUIDE

This prayer guide is designed to help you engage meaningfully during your prayer walks.

- The guide is organized into 7 weeks, each with a theme drawn from the W.A.L.K.I.N.G. acronym
- Some churches may also align sermons with these weekly themes

Each daily prayer walk follows the W.A.L.K. acronym:

W — Worship

Begin by reflecting on the Scripture passage for the day.

A — Ask

Pray through three prompts:

- Personal renewal
- Revival in the Church
- Awakening in our city

These prompts are designed to guide and expand your prayers.

For additional unified prayers, see the Prayers for Greater Houston Appendix.

L — Look

Pray with your eyes open. Ask God to show you people, needs, or opportunities to engage. Refer to the How to Prayer Walk Appendix for ideas on interacting with others during your walk.

K — Keep Praying

Carry one prayer or burden from your walk into the rest of your day.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE

1. Sign Up

Visit www.awakenhouston.org to register and stay connected, access prayer walking and fasting resources, discover opportunities to join prayer gatherings, prayer rooms, and prayer walks, and track our shared progress.

2. Download the Holy Here App

Download at www.holyhere.com and create your account. You're ready to begin prayer walking.

3. Track Your Prayer Walks

Prayer walks will be tracked from Sunday, February 15 through Easter Sunday, April 5.

To record a prayer walk:

1. Click Start a Walk
2. Begin walking and praying
3. Use the daily prayer prompts as a guide
4. (Optional) Record notes or observations
5. Click End Walk
6. Publish your walk (publishing notes is optional)
7. Plan your next prayer walk

Each walk contributes to our collective total once it is published.

WEEK 1: FEBRUARY 16-22

WALK WHERE HE WALKS

Jesus calls His first disciples to leave their nets and follow Him. (Matthew 4:18–22)

As Jesus strolls along the Sea of Galilee, He sees fishermen going about their daily work — ordinary people, busy with the familiar. His simple invitation, “Come, follow Me,” changes everything. To walk where Jesus walks means to leave behind comfort, control, and certainty to embrace a new calling. We begin our Lenten journey by stepping into obedience and discovering that true discipleship always starts with surrender.

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WEEK 1: MONDAY, 02/16

A LIVING SACRIFICE

WORSHIP

Begin by expressing your praise and adoration to God.

“*I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. —Romans 12:1 (ESV)*

ASK

Ask God to guide your prayers as you intercede for your community, responding to what you see as the Spirit leads.

RENEW (Personal): Ask God to renew your willingness to walk where He walks and to break your heart for the things that break His.

REVIVE (Church): Ask God to revive your church community to walk in bold obedience, leaving behind traditions, preferences, and comforts for the sake of His Kingdom coming here on earth.

AWAKEN (City): Ask God to awaken your neighborhood and community to follow Jesus in complete surrender, dying to themselves and coming alive in the discipleship of Jesus Christ.

LOOK

Pray with your eyes open, looking and listening for ways God may invite you to live out your prayers by serving your neighbors.

- Was there an issue I should continue praying into?

KEEP PRAYING

As you finish your prayer walk, carry one prayer or burden with you into the rest of your day.

WEEK 1: TUESDAY, 02/17

THE GOOD SHEPHERD

WORSHIP

Begin by expressing your praise and adoration to God.

“*The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want.
He makes me lie down in green pastures.
He leads me beside still waters.
He restores my soul.
He leads me in paths of righteousness
for his name’s sake.
Psalm 23:1–3 (ESV)*

ASK

Ask God to guide your prayers as you intercede for your community, responding to what you see as the Spirit leads.

RENEW (Personal): Ask God to renew your soul as you pray. Ask Him to still and quiet you as you follow Him beside still waters and green pastures.

REVIVE (Church): Ask God to revive the churches in your community to follow the Good Shepherd wherever He leads, trusting Him by stepping into new avenues of outreach and ministry.

AWAKEN (City): Ask God to awaken the community around you to paths of righteousness. May wickedness and darkness flee before His righteousness and light.

LOOK

Pray with your eyes open, looking and listening for ways God may invite you to live out your prayers by serving your neighbors.

KEEP PRAYING

As you finish your prayer walk, carry one prayer or burden with you into the rest of your day.

WEEK 1: WEDNESDAY, 02/18

CALLED TO BE WITH HIM

WORSHIP

Begin by expressing your praise and adoration to God.

“*And he went up on the mountain and called to him those whom he desired, and they came to him. And he appointed twelve (whom he also named apostles) so that they might be with him and he might send them out to preach and have authority to cast out demons.*
—Mark 3:13–15 (ESV)

ASK

Ask God to guide your prayers as you intercede for your community, responding to what you see as the Spirit leads.

RENEW (Personal): Ask God to renew your desire to be with Him today and to reignite your heart for His mission in the world around you.

REVIVE (Church): Ask God to revive the body of Christ in Houston to the authority given to them in Christ, to carry the message of hope and healing to a hopeless and hurting world.

AWAKEN (City): Ask God to awaken the people of this city to the gracious and audacious invitation to be with Jesus and to be sent out from Jesus into the world.

LOOK

Pray with your eyes open, looking and listening for ways God may invite you to live out your prayers by serving your neighbors.

KEEP PRAYING

As you finish your prayer walk, carry one prayer or burden with you into the rest of your day.

WEEK 1: THURSDAY, 02/19

SENT WITH AUTHORITY

WORSHIP

Begin by expressing your praise and adoration to God.

“*Now the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had directed them. And when they saw him they worshiped him, but some doubted. And Jesus came and said to them, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations...”* —Matthew 28: 16–20 (ESV)

ASK

Ask God to guide your prayers as you intercede for your community, responding to what you see as the Spirit leads.

RENEW (Personal): Ask God to renew your own heart of worship and obedience, responding to the authority of King Jesus with relentless commitment to his mission of making disciples of all nations.

REVIVE (Church): Ask God to revive specific churches in your area to the presence of Jesus in our midst, commissioning us to take the good news of the Kingdom to every man, woman, and child.

AWAKEN (City): Ask God to awaken Houston to the Gospel of Jesus, the love of the Father, and the presence of the Holy Spirit.

LOOK

Pray with your eyes open, looking and listening for ways God may invite you to live out your prayers by serving your neighbors.

KEEP PRAYING

As you finish your prayer walk, carry one prayer or burden with you into the rest of your day.

WALK WHERE HE WALKS

WEEK 1: FRIDAY, 02/20

TRUSTING HIS LEAD

WORSHIP

Begin by expressing your praise and adoration to God.

*“Trust in the Lord with all your heart,
and do not lean on your own understanding.
In all your ways acknowledge him,
and he will make straight your paths.
Proverbs 3:5–6 (ESV)*

ASK

Ask God to guide your prayers as you intercede for your community, responding to what you see as the Spirit leads.

RENEW (Personal): Ask God to renew your trust in his leading. Surrender your competency and expertise, depending completely on his sufficiency, strength, and power.

REVIVE (Church): Ask God to revive followers of Jesus across the city to acknowledge his leadership in all things and allow him to make straight the path before us.

AWAKEN (City): Ask God to awaken specific people you know to repent and follow Jesus, placing their faith in the Lord and trusting him with all their hearts.

LOOK

Pray with your eyes open, looking and listening for ways God may invite you to live out your prayers by serving your neighbors.

- Was there a need I noticed that I could help meet?
- Was there an issue I should continue praying into?

KEEP PRAYING

As you finish your prayer walk, carry one prayer or burden with you into the rest of your day.

WEEK 1: SATURDAY, 02/21

HERE I AM, SEND ME

WORSHIP

Begin by expressing your praise and adoration to God.

“*And I heard the voice of the Lord saying, “Whom shall I send, and who will go for us?” Then I said, “Here I am! Send me.” —Isaiah 6:8 (ESV)*

ASK

Ask God to guide your prayers as you intercede for your community, responding to what you see as the Spirit leads.

RENEW (Personal): Ask God to renew your sensitivity to hearing His voice call out to you. Ask Him to speak to you anew and afresh today, then take some time to listen.

REVIVE (Church): Ask God to revive His people all over our city to respond to His call to be His hands and feet to our community.

AWAKEN (City): Ask God to awaken eyes, ears, and hearts to see Jesus for who He is, to hear the Holy Spirit call out to them, and to repent and believe in the Gospel, responding in whole-life obedience.

LOOK

Pray with your eyes open, looking and listening for ways God may invite you to live out your prayers by serving your neighbors.

- Was there a need I noticed that I could help meet?
- Was there an issue I should continue praying into?

KEEP PRAYING

As you finish your prayer walk, carry one prayer or burden with you into the rest of your day.



WEEK 1: SUNDAY, 02/22

LEAVING OUR NETS

WORSHIP

Begin by expressing your praise and adoration to God.

“While walking by the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon (who is called Peter) and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea, for they were fishermen. And he said to them, “Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men.” Immediately they left their nets and followed him. And going on from there he saw two other brothers, James the son of Zebedee and John his brother, in the boat with Zebedee their father, mending their nets, and he called them. Immediately they left the boat and their father and followed him. —Matthew 4:18–22 (ESV)

ASK

Ask God to guide your prayers as you intercede for your community, responding to what you see as the Spirit leads.

RENEW (Personal): Ask God to renew your passion to see men and women come to faith in Jesus Christ, and for boldness to forsake all and follow His call on your life.

REVIVE (Church): Ask God to revive the Church in Houston to be fishers of men and women, igniting a revival of evangelism and bold Gospel proclamation.

AWAKEN (City): Ask God to awaken the city of Houston to hear and respond to Jesus’ call, seeing radical acts of obedience beyond anything we could ask or imagine.

LOOK

Pray with your eyes open, looking and listening for ways God may invite you to live out your prayers by serving your neighbors.

- Was there a need I noticed that I could help meet?
- Was there an issue I should continue praying into?

KEEP PRAYING

As you finish your prayer walk, carry one prayer or burden with you into the rest of your day.

WEEK 2: FEBRUARY 23–MARCH 1

AUTHENTIC RELATIONSHIP

***Jesus shows that walking with Him is about relationship, not rules.
(Matthew 12:1–8)***

When the Pharisees challenge Jesus over Sabbath traditions, He responds with grace and truth: “I desire mercy, not sacrifice.” Walking with Jesus is not about rigid religion, but real relationship. He calls us to move from ritual to relationship — from legalism to love — learning that His presence offers rest for the soul and freedom from performance-driven faith.

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WEEK 2: MONDAY, 02/23

PEACE IN HIS PRESENCE

WORSHIP

Begin by expressing your praise and adoration to God.

“As they were talking about these things, Jesus himself stood among them and said to them, “Peace to you!” But they were startled and frightened and thought they saw a spirit. And he said to them, “Why are you troubled, and why do doubts arise in your hearts? See my hands and my feet, that it is I myself. Touch me, and see. For a spirit does not have flesh and bones as you see that I have.” —Luke 24:36–39 (ESV)

ASK

Ask God to guide your prayers as you intercede for your community, responding to what you see as the Spirit leads.

RENEW (Personal): Ask God to renew your mind and give you “sight” to see Him, and what He accomplished on the cross, from His perspective, especially in the unexpected circumstances of your life.

REVIVE (Church): Ask God to release a desire in your church community to have a radical encounter with Jesus through the trials, challenges, and disappointments your community may be facing.

AWAKEN (City): Ask God to remove spiritual blindness from each person you come across on your walk; may each person in our city encounter the resurrected Christ in a very personal way and be folded into God’s redemptive story.

LOOK

Pray with your eyes open, looking and listening for ways God may invite you to live out your prayers by serving your neighbors.

KEEP PRAYING

As you finish your prayer walk, carry one prayer or burden with you into the rest of your day.

WEEK 2: TUESDAY, 02/24

COME AND SEE

WORSHIP

Begin by expressing your praise and adoration to God.

“*So the woman left her water jar and went away into town and said to the people, “Come, see a man who told me all that I ever did. Can this be the Christ?” They went out of the town and were coming to him.*
John 4:28–30 (ESV)

ASK

Ask God to guide your prayers as you intercede for your community, responding to what you see as the Spirit leads.

RENEW (Personal): Ask God for courage to go deeper in intimate relationship with Him so that you are set free through submission to the promptings of the Spirit to confess, repent, forgive, and live honestly before God.

REVIVE (Church): Ask God for revival in your church community where confession and hidden sin are brought to the light and met by abundant grace and mercy that sets the captives free.

AWAKEN (City): Ask God to soften the hearts of those in your neighborhood and community to prepare them to receive saving grace, and pray for them to encounter believers (you!) who are willing to share their testimony in love so that they are drawn into the Kingdom of God.

LOOK

Pray with your eyes open, looking and listening for ways God may invite you to live out your prayers by serving your neighbors.

KEEP PRAYING

As you finish your prayer walk, carry one prayer or burden with you into the rest of your day.

WEEK 2: WEDNESDAY, 02/25

DRAWING NEAR WITHOUT SHAME

WORSHIP

Begin by expressing your praise and adoration to God.

“*One of the Pharisees asked him to eat with him, and he went into the Pharisee’s house and reclined at table. And behold, a woman of the city, who was a sinner, when she learned that he was reclining at table in the Pharisee’s house, brought an alabaster flask of ointment, and standing behind him at his feet, weeping, she began to wet his feet with her tears and wiped them with the hair of her head and kissed his feet and anointed them with the ointment. —Luke 7:36–38 (ESV)*

ASK

Ask God to guide your prayers as you intercede for your community, responding to what you see as the Spirit leads.

RENEW (Personal): Ask God to deliver you from any conscious or unconscious insecurities and shame that hinder you from approaching Jesus authentically and honestly.

REVIVE (Church): Ask God to deliver your church community from any religious striving and deepen in authentic, self-giving communal worship.

AWAKEN (City): Ask God to deliver the city of Houston from hard-heartedness and that the Light of the World may be revealed to all in the city.

LOOK

Pray with your eyes open, looking and listening for ways God may invite you to live out your prayers by serving your neighbors.

KEEP PRAYING

As you finish your prayer walk, carry one prayer or burden with you into the rest of your day.

WEEK 2: THURSDAY, 02/26

CRYING OUT FOR MERCY

WORSHIP

Begin by expressing your praise and adoration to God.

“*And they came to Jericho. And as he was leaving Jericho with his disciples and a great crowd, Bartimaeus, a blind beggar, the son of Timaeus, was sitting by the roadside. And when he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to cry out and say, “Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!” And many rebuked him, telling him to be silent. But he cried out all the more, “Son of David, have mercy on me!” And Jesus stopped and said, “Call him.” And they called the blind man, saying to him, “Take heart. Get up; he is calling you.” —Mark 10:46–49 (ESV)*

ASK

Ask God to guide your prayers as you intercede for your community, responding to what you see as the Spirit leads.

RENEW (Personal): Ask God to renew your willingness to hear and respond to His calling out to you.

REVIVE (Church): Ask God to unify your church community, calling out to the Lord with expectation on behalf of the people God has called you to serve and love.

AWAKEN (City): Ask God to shine His face upon Houston as we call out to Him on its behalf, asking Him to heal our city from idolatry of lesser things (feel free to name those idols).

LOOK

Pray with your eyes open, looking and listening for ways God may invite you to live out your prayers by serving your neighbors.

- Was there a conversation I had that stood out?
- Was there a need I noticed that I could help meet?
- Was there an issue I should continue praying into?

KEEP PRAYING

As you finish your prayer walk, carry one prayer or burden with you into the rest of your day.



WEEK 2: FRIDAY, 02/27

FORGIVENESS THAT FREES

WORSHIP

Begin by expressing your praise and adoration to God.

“Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours. And whenever you stand praying, forgive, if you have anything against anyone, so that your Father also who is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses. —Mark 11:24–25 (ESV)

ASK

Ask God to guide your prayers as you intercede for your community, responding to what you see as the Spirit leads.

RENEW (Personal): Ask God to strengthen your conviction, desire, and willingness to walk in forgiveness and forgive those who have offended you.

REVIVE (Church): Ask God to reconcile conflicts within your church community and together walk in forgiveness, leaning into hard conversations and severing any root of bitterness to the glory of God.

AWAKEN (City): Ask God to hover over the city of Houston this year, that His peace may pierce the darkness in ways that draw people to Him.

LOOK

Pray with your eyes open, looking and listening for ways God may invite you to live out your prayers by serving your neighbors.

- Was there an issue I should continue praying into?

KEEP PRAYING

As you finish your prayer walk, carry one prayer or burden with you into the rest of your day.

WEEK 2: SATURDAY, 02/28

WALKING HUMBLY WITH GOD

WORSHIP

Begin by expressing your praise and adoration to God.

“*He has told you, O man, what is good; and what does the LORD require of you but to do justice, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God? —Micah 6:8 (ESV)*

ASK

Ask God to guide your prayers as you intercede for your community, responding to what you see as the Spirit leads.

RENEW (Personal): Ask God to increase your joy as you humbly abide in Christ and allow the Spirit to lead you in acts of justice and kindness.

REVIVE (Church): Ask God to deepen your church community’s appreciation and worship of Him so that a fresh wind of the Spirit moves among you, bringing greater clarity of mission.

AWAKEN (City): Ask God to redeem the city of Houston’s reputation, that it becomes a place known for justice and kindness because of a flourishing partnership with the Church, known for its humility.

LOOK

Pray with your eyes open, looking and listening for ways God may invite you to live out your prayers by serving your neighbors.

KEEP PRAYING

As you finish your prayer walk, carry one prayer or burden with you into the rest of your day.

WEEK 2: SUNDAY, 03/01

MERCY OVER SACRIFICE

WORSHIP

Begin by expressing your praise and adoration to God.

“*I tell you, something greater than the temple is here. And if you had known what this means, ‘I desire mercy, and not sacrifice,’ you would not have condemned the guiltless. For the Son of Man is lord of the Sabbath. —Matthew 12:6–8 (ESV)*

ASK

Ask God to guide your prayers as you intercede for your community, responding to what you see as the Spirit leads.

RENEW (Personal): Ask God to impart to you His humble heart of compassion for those you were created to be in relationship with (especially those who irritate you) and to love them as the Spirit leads you, as an offering to Him.

REVIVE (Church): Ask God to empower your church community to walk in newness of life like never before, forsaking any fear of man or fear of being misunderstood, and boldly serving your community in ways that challenge the religious status quo.

AWAKEN (City): Ask God to awaken our city to experience revival that begins in our own hearts, to the glory of God.

LOOK

Pray with your eyes open, looking and listening for ways God may invite you to live out your prayers by serving your neighbors.

- Was there a need I noticed that I could help meet?
- Was there an issue I should continue praying into?

KEEP PRAYING

As you finish your prayer walk, carry one prayer or burden with you into the rest of your day.

WEEK 3: MARCH 2–8

LAUNCH OUT BY FAITH

***Peter steps out of the boat and walks on the water toward Jesus.
(Matthew 14:22–33)***

In the darkness of the storm, Jesus appears, walking on the waves. Peter's decision to step out of the boat is a moment of breathtaking courage and trust. Faith means moving toward Jesus even when fear and uncertainty swirl around us. This week, we learn that walking with Jesus often means leaving the safety of what we know to experience His power in what we cannot control.

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WEEK 3: MONDAY, 03/02

WALKING BY FAITH

WORSHIP

Begin by expressing your praise and adoration to God.

“*For we walk by faith, not by sight.*
2 Corinthians 5:7 (ESV)”

ASK

Ask God to guide your prayers as you intercede for your community, responding to what you see as the Spirit leads.

RENEW (Personal): Ask God to renew your faith to walk by faith and not by sight today.

REVIVE (Church): Ask God to revive the heart of your church to deeper faith and trust in the Lord.

AWAKEN (City): Ask God to pour out His Spirit on our city and awaken revival. May Houston become a city of God.

LOOK

Pray with your eyes open, looking and listening for ways God may invite you to live out your prayers by serving your neighbors.

LAUNCH OUT BY FAITH

WEEK 3: TUESDAY, 03/03

NOT BY MIGHT, BUT BY HIS SPIRIT

WORSHIP

Begin by expressing your praise and adoration to God.
