Sermon Discussion Guide

February 1st, 2026 | The Letter to the Colossians

Prayer

Take time before discussion to take prayer requests and pray for each member of the group that requests prayer.

Read Colossians 1:21-23 out loud as a group.

1. How does the truth that Christ “has now reconciled you in His body of flesh through death to present you before him holy and blameless and beyond reproach” ground your identity? Have you ever struggled to fully believe and live out this reality?
2. What does it look like for you to daily “continue in the faith firmly established and steadfast?”

Read Colossians 1:24-27 out loud as a group.

3. Why do you think Paul is able to rejoice in his sufferings? How can suffering have purpose and not just pain?
4. In what ways may The Lord be calling you to participate in the ministry of The Gospel?
5. Paul says that “God willed to make known what the wealth of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles is”. How does knowing that God produces the results of our ministry change the way we faithfully carry out the work God has assigned to us?

Read Colossians 1:28-29 out loud as a group.

6. Who in your life can you proclaim Christ to? How would you explain to them “Christ in you, the hope of glory”?
7. What does it look like practically for us as we aim to encourage, admonish, and teach each other in The Lord?
8. How can we allow life’s circumstances, good or bad, to grow our dependence on Christ? Is there anywhere where you are striving in your own strength instead of the power He supplies?
