Sermon Discussion Guide

February 8th, 2026 | The Letter to the Colossians

Prayer

Take time before discussion to take prayer requests and pray for each member of the group that requests prayer.

Read Colossians 2:1-7 out loud as a group.

1. What does it mean for you to “have complete confidence that you understand God’s mysterious plan, which is Christ himself”?
2. Why is it often so easy for us to be deceived by well-crafted arguments?
3. What does it look like for you to walk in Christ, and not just to have received Christ?

Read Colossians 2:8-15 out loud as a group.

4. Where have you been tempted to need something other than Christ to feel complete?
5. Are there any old identities that you still allow to define who you are?
6. What fears, accusations, or authorities still try to make you live as though you’re not forgiven and free?

Read Colossians 2:16-23 out loud as a group.

7. How do humanism, legalism, mysticism, and asceticism pull Christ from the center of our faith and place ourselves at the center?
8. Do you or have you ever found yourself wrestling with one of these deceptions?
