Jesus Calms the Storm

Matthew 8:23-27, Mark 4:35-41, Luke 8:22-25

Story:

- ★ **Introduction & Story:** This is a shorter story, so this is a good time to have the kids find the story in the Bible and follow along as you read one of the passages.

Jesus had been teaching all day by the Sea of Galilee. When evening came, he got into a boat with his disciples and set out for the other side of the lake. Other people got into boats too and followed them.

When they were far from shore, a storm came up. Great waves dashed upon the boat and the boat began to fill with water. The disciples were very afraid and believed they were in danger.

But Jesus was very tired and he had fallen asleep in the back of the boat on a cushion. The disciples woke him up and said, "Lord, save us! We're going to die!"

Then he got up and rebuked the wind and the raging waves. The waves stopped, and there was calm. He said to the disciples, "Where is your faith?"

They were fearful and amazed, asking one another, "Who then is this? He commands even the winds and the waves, and they obey him!"

- ★ **Additional Thoughts:**

- Connections: Jesus continues to show that He is God.
- Theological: Jesus controls everything - including nature.
- Historical: The Sea of Galilee is well known for storms coming on suddenly.

Follow Up:

- ★ **Retell:** Have kids share what they recall from the story. Fill in any major holes they missed. This is a good one to re-enact and have them practice until they each know the story.

- ★ **Examine:**

- Comp questions:

- Why do you think the disciples were so afraid?
 - How could Jesus sleep when the storm was all around them?
 - The disciples were amazed that Jesus could calm the storm. Do you think maybe they didn't understand that he had such power?
- Ask, "What do we learn about God from this story? What does He do?" He controls everything. He controls nature.
 - Ask, "What do we learn about humans from this story? What are humans doing?" We become anxious and scared even when we know Jesus - but we shouldn't!
- ★ **Application:** Ask, "What is Jesus asking us to do through this story? Why did God include this in the Bible?" We don't need to have fear; we need to have faith.

STILLING THE STORM

New Testament Lesson #45

Jesus had spent the day teaching a large crowd of people about the kingdom of God (Mark 4:1-2). By evening, Jesus must have been tired.

The parallel account in Matthew 8:18 indicates that when he saw the great crowds, he gave orders to go to the other side of the Sea of Galilee. Mark reports that his disciples took him "just as he was," after they had sent away the crowds.

Jesus was with the disciples in a large boat, and other, smaller boats followed. Jesus lay down and slept. A sudden storm developed. The strong wind sent waves that began filling the boat. Even though they were experienced with the sea, the disciples were frightened. They woke Jesus with the words, "Teacher, don't you care if we drown?" Jesus spoke to the wind, commanding, "Quiet! Be still!" And there was a great calm.

He then asked the disciples why they had been afraid. He said, "Do you still have no faith?" The disciples were awestruck when they saw that the wind and the sea obeyed Him. They asked one another, "Who is this? Even the wind and waves obey him!"

POINTS TO CONSIDER:


- In the Bible, people often learned lessons from the behavior of nature. For example, Elijah learned from wind, earthquake and fire that God had not abandoned him (I Kings 19:9-18).
