

Dear Church Family Member,

I hope you know how deeply grateful I am for you and for the unique way you are part of our church family. As Jesus said in **Matthew 6:21**, “For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.” Giving shapes our hearts to reflect the priorities of God’s kingdom.

Thank you for being part of this church family. Your presence, prayers, and partnership make a difference that often extends far beyond what we can see. I am continually encouraged by the ways God is moving through our congregation, and I look forward to all He will do as we continue this mission together. Please know that I am praying for you and your family—that you would experience God’s provision, peace, and joy in every season.
