There is a difference between "helping out" and wanting to become a student leader. It is for that reason that we do not simply accept "anyone with a pulse" to join MS+. Not only are we committed to you, and your development, it is also a commitment to Metro Students, MS+ and its leadership.

Factors that will be considered for acceptance into MS+ Student Leadership Development Team:

- A testimony of salvation
- Faithfulness to Metro Students Wednesday night services and Metropolitan Church Sunday services
- Respected among their peers
- A Servant-hearted attitude
- Your current activity schedule (time available to truly be an active part of MS+?)
- High School Student
- Once selected to MS+, you will have certain requirements to follow:
  - Live in a way that reflects 1 Timothy 4:12 "Don't let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, and purity."
  - Finish the required reading (a student leadership book will be provided)
  - As a team, plan and lead one service project for the school year you serve
  - As a team, plan and lead one entire Metro Student Wednesday night service (one service per semester)
  - Support upcoming Metro Student trips and activities
  - Attend scheduled meetings as a team with Pastor Clint/Michael Smith
  - Be open to receiving developmental feedback

## A MS+ Student Leadership Development Team Member must:

- 1) Have accepted Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord of your life, having a daily relationship with Him and your lifestyle reflecting that genuine relationship.
- 2) Have a regular quiet time with God, including time in God's Word and prayer.
- 3) Submit to the accountability of lead pastor, student pastor, pastoral staff, and Metro Students Team Leaders.
- 4) Be an active and faithful member of the Metropolitan Church.
- 5) Live a life that is honoring & pleasing to the Lord by abstaining from any worldly activities such as parties, alcohol consumption, drugs, etc.
- 6) Be faithful in attendance for Sunday morning LifeGroups, Wednesday night Student Service, MS+ meetings, events, hangouts, service projects, and trips.
- 7) Communicate with Pastor Clint when you are unable to attend aforementioned activities.
- 8) Arrive at your ministry position at the agreed upon time by Pastor Clint or student leader. Being on time is a matter of integrity. Every late person affects the entire ministry.
