

ADULT BIBLE CLASSES (9:45-10:30AM)

Young Adults (Rm. 207-209): Title: Soul Care 101: A biblical survival guide for developing life-giving spiritual habits.

Description: In a world that celebrates hustle & productivity, your soul was designed for a different rhythm. This class explores how to find true rest in the person & work of Christ, moving beyond 'quick fixes' to the deep, soul-anchoring truths of the Gospel. Teacher: Craig Parker

Adult Class (Rm. 202-204): Title: God's Holy Spirit

Description: Based on Gordon Fee's book "Paul, the Spirit, & the People of God", this class will seek to recover an understanding of God's Holy Spirit & how He functions both in our individual lives & in the Church. Adult Class (Rm. 206-208): Title: Being there for the Lost: Teachings from the extravagant love of Jesus.

Description: Beyond the boundaries of religious duty lies the radical, self-emptying love of Christ. In this study, we examine the 'extravagant love' Jesus demonstrated toward outcasts & the lost - breaking social norms to offer radical forgiveness & grace. We will move past our fears & biases to see the humanity in everyone, just as Jesus did. Come discover how a simple gesture of 'extravagant love' can become a divine appointment for someone in need. Ladies Class: (Rm. 203): Title: As For Me, Life Through the Lens of the Psalms.

Description: From songs of praise to cries of lament & everything in-between, the book of Psalm captures the emotions of life.
