



The **Road to Joy** devotional will pair with our sermon series from Ash Wednesday through Easter Sunday. Journey and Grow with Us!



Nutritious Snacks for Pre-school Children

- Fruit Kebabs: *Cut up different fruits and place them on skewers for a fun and healthy snack*
- Kale Chips: Made from raw or baked kale, these chips are rich in nutrients and provide fiber
- Fruit Smoothies: Combine fresh or frozen fruits with low-fat milk for a nutritious drink
- Carrots with Hummus: Baby carrots can be packed in lunches, and hummus adds protein and fiber
