



# STEPS OF A DISCIPLESHIP MEETING!

Your time together should be around 1 hour to 1.5 hours. Plan to meet at a consistent time weekly, or biweekly.

## STEP 2: PRAY OVER YOUR TIME TOGETHER


The opening prayer is a way for us to invite God into our time together, center our hearts on Him, and prepare ourselves for the discussions ahead. This is an opportunity to thank God for His presence, ask for His guidance and wisdom, and open our hearts to what He wants to teach us.

Discuss any prayer requests each of you might have, then pray over each other before leaving!






# READ: GENESIS 12

## QUESTIONS

1. How does the concept of God's mission in Genesis 12 relate to our personal callings today? In what ways might God be asking you to 'go' or step out in faith?
2. Abram's obedience, trust, and faith are highlighted in the sermon. How can we cultivate these qualities in our own spiritual lives, especially when facing uncertainty?
3. The sermon mentions that we are meant to be a blessing to others, not just recipients of blessings. How can you use the blessings in your life to bless those around you?
4. How does the idea of spiritual leadership, as exemplified by Abram leading his family, apply to our roles in our families and communities today?
5. The pastor discusses how life's trials can challenge our faith. How have you experienced this, and what strategies have you found helpful in maintaining faith during difficult times?
6. The sermon emphasizes that God's call doesn't guarantee an easy life. How does this perspective change the way we approach challenges in our faith journey?
7. How can we balance trusting in God's guidance with taking practical action in our lives, as illustrated by Abram's journey and decisions?
8. The sermon concludes by warning about tests that may detour us from God's mission. How can we stay vigilant and prepared for such challenges in our spiritual walk?
