



# STEPS OF A DISCIPLESHIP MEETING!

## STEP 2: PRAY OVER YOUR TIME TOGETHER




## STEP 3: READ AND DISCUSS!

Discuss any prayer requests each of you might have, then pray over each other before leaving!






# READ: GENESIS 13

## QUESTIONS

1. How do the choices of Abram and Lot reflect the daily spiritual decisions we face, and what can we learn from their diverging paths?
2. In what ways might our lives 'mirror' those of biblical figures like Abram or Lot, and how can we ensure we're following God's direction rather than worldly temptations?
3. How does the concept of 'crossroads' apply to our spiritual lives, and what strategies can we employ to consistently choose God's path?
4. What does Abram's willingness to let Lot choose first reveal about his character and faith, and how can we cultivate similar trust in God's provision?
5. How does God's reaffirmation of His covenant with Abram inspire hope in our own lives, especially during times of uncertainty or apparent setbacks?
6. In what ways do we sometimes 'pitch our tents toward Sodom' in our own lives, and how can we recognize and resist the gradual pull of sin?
7. How does the parallel between God providing a son for Abram and providing Jesus as a savior for humanity deepen our understanding of God's redemptive plan?
8. What does it mean practically to 'practice faith by trusting God through obedience' in our daily lives and decisions?
9. How can we better align our lives with God's mission of sharing the gospel and making disciples, and what obstacles might we need to overcome?
10. In what areas of your life do you struggle to trust God's provision, and how might embracing His mission change your perspective on those challenges?
