
DAY 1: GOD'S FAITHFULNESS IN THE IMPOSSIBLE

Reading: Genesis 18:1-15

Abraham and Sarah's story reminds us that nothing is impossible for God.

Even when circumstances seem hopeless, God remains faithful to His promises. Reflect on a time when you faced an "impossible" situation. How did God show His faithfulness?

Today, consider areas in your life where you need to trust God's faithfulness more fully. Pray for the faith to believe in God's power to do the impossible in your life and the lives of those around you.






DAY 2: RESPONDING TO GOD'S FAITHFULNESS

Reading: Hebrews 11:8-19

Abraham's faith journey teaches us how to respond to God's faithfulness. He trusted God enough to obey, even when the path ahead was unclear. What step of faith is God calling you to take today?

It might be forgiving someone, sharing your faith, or making a difficult decision. Remember that our obedience is a response to God's faithfulness. Ask God for the courage to step out in faith, trusting His faithful guidance.






DAY 3: GOD'S FAITHFULNESS IN DEALING WITH SIN

Reading: Romans 3:21-26

The story of Sodom and Gomorrah shows God's faithfulness in dealing with sin. While this can seem harsh, it reveals God's justice and holiness. Yet, through Christ, we see God's ultimate faithfulness in providing a way for our sins to be forgiven. Spend time today examining your heart. Are there sins you need to confess?

Thank God for His faithfulness in providing forgiveness through Jesus, and ask for His help in turning away from sin and towards righteousness.






DAY 4: INTERCESSION AND COMPASSION

Reading: Genesis 18:16–33

Abraham's intercession for Sodom demonstrates compassion for others, even those living in sin. How can we balance righteous living with compassion for those who don't know God?

Pray for those in your community who are far from God. Ask for opportunities to show them God's love and for the courage to share the gospel. Consider how you can be an intercessor for others, standing in the gap as Abraham did.





DAY 5: FINDING OUR WAY HOME IN GOD'S FAITHFULNESS

Reading: Lamentations 3:22–26

Just as knowing the location of Highway 321 helps one find their way home, remembering God's faithfulness guides us through life's challenges. When we feel lost or disoriented, God's faithfulness is our compass. Reflect on times when you've felt lost spiritually. How did God's faithfulness bring you back?

Today, make a list of ways God has been faithful in your life. Use this as a reminder when you face future trials, trusting that God's faithfulness will always lead you home.
