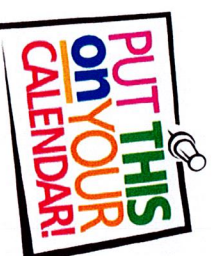
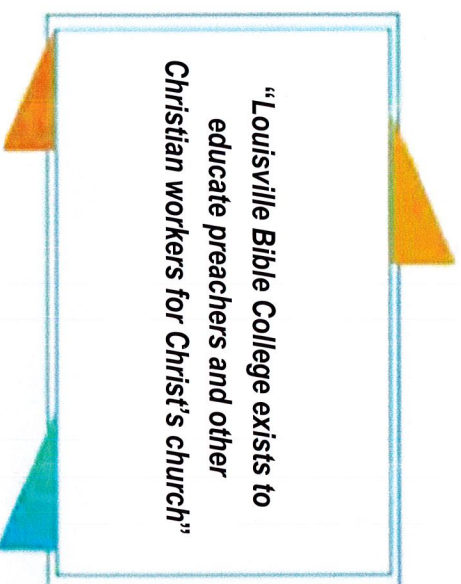
The LBC family extends sincere sympathy to the following:

Jim Boyer on the passing of his brother, Ray, on December 9. Jim is a long-time LBC faculty member.

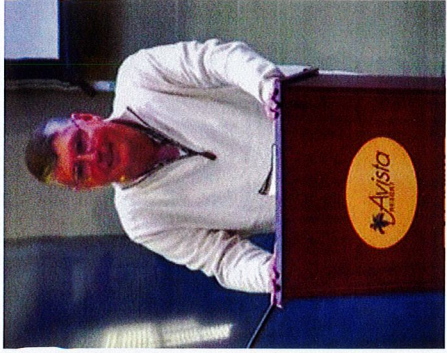
Leonard Daunhauer Jr., father of Maria Anderson, passed away December 20. Maria is an LBC alumna and wife of VP Jason Anderson.

- **Philippians 4:6:** (In President Allen's words...) "Don't worry about anything, pray about everything, give thanks in all things."

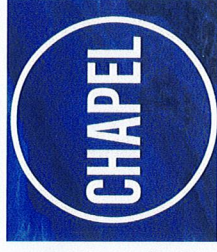

This is not a merger of ministries. Both LBC and CE will continue to operate autonomously under the direction of their individual boards.

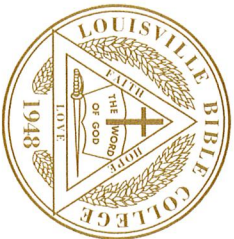


LBC holds chapel services throughout the semester. We believe it is important to not only gain knowledge but also to increase the fellowship we share with each other.

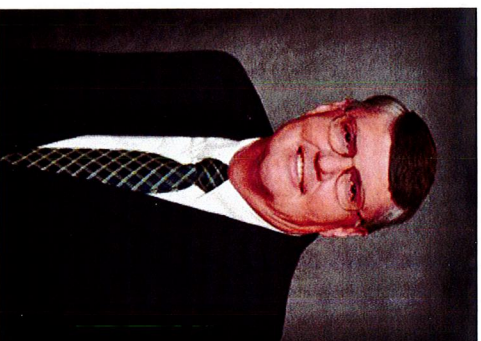
