



# YOUR MISSIONARIES THE RICHARDS TO GERMANY




DEAR PASTOR AND CHURCH,

**FILLING IN AND FELLOWSHIP** — In addition to the family camp we had several fellowship and outreach activities such as potlucks, picnicks, discipleship events, etc. These past two months have truly been very busy. In addition to all the activities here in Metzingen, both Missionary Jeremy Randle and I filled in for my son, Missionary Seth Richards, while he was preaching at a missions conference in Alaska. Jeremy and I filled in for Seth's midweek Thursday night service and his Sunday services for the two weeks that he was out of the country. This was a wonderful time to catch up and fellowship with the people in Ingolstadt.

**UKRAINIAN OUTREACH** – Since the Russian war against the Ukraine began, there has been an increase of around one million Ukrainian refugees to Germany. Because of the declining birth rate in Germany, an increase in the population is a positive thing for Germany's future. This is also an amazing opportunity to reach more Europeans with the gospel message. Praise the Lord! Through our visitation outreach program, we have met many Ukrainian refugees. Since many of them have limited German and English language skills, we are using tracts in Ukrainian to share the gospel with them. We have also placed an order for the Ukrainian 'THIS WAS YOUR LIFE' Chick tracts. We can now give both German and Ukrainian tracts to refugees so they can, most importantly, get the Gospel message and they can also use both tracts together (Ukrainian and German) to improve their German language skills. Please pray about this part of our ministry.
