



Welcome to 101. We are so glad you have decided to begin our NEXT Track. We want to celebrate your decision to follow Christ with you! Whether you have committed your life to Christ for the first time or have recently rededicated your life, we are thrilled to celebrate with you.

101 is an introduction to what it means to follow Jesus. Each week we will explore Scriptures, principles, and practices to help you better understand the decision you have made. We will also equip you with some practical next steps as you begin this new journey.
