Friday, December 11, 2015, is a day that I will remember for the rest of my life. I was in the parking lot of a restaurant while my wife and three boys had just walked inside to place their orders. While walking into the restaurant, I received a call from a surgeon who had performed an outpatient procedure on me four days earlier. He proceeded to tell me that the pathology report of the biopsy came back as a form of lymphoma. He was very kind, but assured me that I would need to follow up with an oncologist and begin the discussion of “chemical treatment.” Needless to say, I was stunned. I can still remember thanking him for his call and walking into the restaurant and telling my wife of the surgeon’s call. I attempted to repeat the conversation with her in such a way as not to let our boys know what was going on.

Perhaps you are reading this booklet in response to a similar type of phone call. If so, my heart goes out to you. The good news is that we have a Heavenly Father who is a very present help in our time of need. The Holy Spirit is our Comforter and Jesus Christ is our Healer. He has gone before us and has already made provision for our healing.

My story continues with a PET Scan, CT Scan and a bone marrow biopsy. Everything that I went through was a deepening experience. Even though God did not send the storm, He invaded the storm. I was reminded of James 1:2 *“Count it all joy, my brothers, when you meet trials of various kinds.”* I found that in the Greek the word “trial” meant a “test with a beneficial outcome.” By God’s grace, I was determined that this test would have a beneficial outcome in my life. Instead of simply being focused upon *“How do I get out of this?”* my focus shifted to *“What can I get out of this?”* I wanted the trial to be for *“God’s Glory and my good.”* Seeing God’s faithfulness time and time again during this season only served to deepen my love for Him, my love for others who are in similar battles and my love for my wife and family. Through the six rounds of chemo, God’s Word was my anchor. It kept me from drifting into fear. The Word of God and the care of my Heavenly Father gave me a strength and comfort that forever changed my life.

During the four months of chemo, I put together these passages of scripture. There were days that I was so weak that my only accomplishment was that I was able to read aloud God’s Word. Faith comes as we hear God’s Word. Keeping my mind renewed to God’s promises was vital to staying out of fear. About midway through my treatment, I sensed the Lord speak something to my heart that changed everything. I sensed him saying, *“What are you expecting?”* I believe He was encouraging me to *“expect”* to see answers to the scriptures that I had been quoting. From that point on, more than just reading verses, I would preface the verses by saying, *“I am expecting....”* Honestly, that small adjustment changed everything. My faith went from being “passive” to being “active.”

It is my prayer that these verses and confessions that held me up during the toughest season of my life will be a resource and an encouragement to you. You can make it. God is with you.

Confession: *“I am not afraid of the fire of chemotherapy.”*

“And these three men, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, fell down bound into the midst of the burning fiery furnace. Then Nebuchadnezzar the king was astounded, and rose up in haste, and spake, and said unto his counsellors, ‘Did not we cast three men bound into the midst of the fire?’ They answered and said unto the king, ‘True, O king.’ He answered and said, ‘Lo, *I see four men loose, walking in the midst of the fire, and they have no hurt (damage)*; and the form of the fourth is like the Son of God.’”

Confession: “*I will keep Him. The Lord is keeping me from the ‘flames’ of chemotherapy. Chemotherapy doesn’t have power over my body to damage and destroy it.*”

“Let the weak say, ‘*I am strong.*’”

Zechariah 4:6 KJV

“This is the word of the LORD unto Zerubbabel, saying, ‘*Not by might, nor by power, but by my spirit, saith the LORD of hosts.*’”

Confession: “*God alone will receive all the glory for all the good that is done.*”

Matthew 4:1-11 KJV

“Then was Jesus led up of the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil. And when he had fasted forty days and forty nights, he was afterward an hungred. “... that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: ‘***He Himself took our (my) infirmities and bore our (my) sicknesses.***’”

Matthew 11:12 KJV

“And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffereth violence, ***and the violent take it by force.***” (“***Violent men seize it by force [as a precious prize].***” AMP)

Matthew 11:28–30 NKJV

“Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and ***I will give you rest.*** Take My yoke upon you ***and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy and My burden is light.***”

Matthew 18:18–20 KJV

“Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven. Confession: *“I forbid the side affects of chemotherapy from negatively affecting my body. I will benefit from the good of the treatment and resist all destructive side effects. I forbid any permanent damage to my body. I receive supernatural strength into my life.”*

Mark 4:35–41 NKJV

“On the same day, when evening had come, He said to them, *“Let us cross over to the other side.”* Now when they had left the multitude, they took Him along in the boat as He was. And other little boats were also with Him. And a great windstorm arose, and the waves beat into the boat, so that it was already filling. *But He was in the stern, asleep on a pillow.* And they awoke Him and said to Him, ‘Teacher, do You not care that we are perishing?’ *Then He arose and rebuked the wind, and said to the sea, ‘Peace, be still!’* And the wind ceased and there was a great calm. But He said to them, *‘Why are you so fearful? How is it that you have no faith?’* And they feared exceedingly, and said to one another, ‘Who can this be, that even the wind and the sea obey Him!’”

Confession: *“I am crossing to the other side of this storm in peace.”*

“For they all saw Him and were troubled. But immediately He talked with them and said to them, *‘Be of good cheer! It is I; do not be afraid.’*”

Confession: *“In the midst of this storm, I will be of good cheer.”*

Mark 11:22–24 KJV

“And Jesus answering saith unto them, ‘Have faith in God. For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, *“Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea;”* and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; *he shall have whatsoever he saith.* Therefore I say unto you, *What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have*

them.” (My part is to “believe that I have received.” God’s part is to see to it that I have it. That’s not my part; it is God’s part.)

Confession: *“All disease is removed out of my body.”*

Mark 16:17-18 KJV

“And these signs shall follow them that believe; in my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; they shall take up serpents; *and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.*”

Confession: *“Recovery is working in my body now.”*

Mark 16:20 KJV

“And they went forth, and preached every where, *the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following. Amen.*”

Confession: *“The Lord is working with me, confirming His Word with supernatural signs and wonders.”*

Luke 1:45 KJV

“And blessed is she that believed: *for there shall be a performance of those things which were told her from the Lord.*”

Confession: *“The Lord will perform every promise that has been spoken to me.”*

Luke 10:38-42 ESV

“Now as they went on their way, Jesus entered a village. And a woman named Martha welcomed him into her house. And she had a sister called Mary, who sat at the Lord’s feet and listened to his teaching. *But Martha was distracted with much serving.* And she went up to him and said, ‘Lord, do you not care that my sister has left me to serve alone? Tell her then to help me.’ *But the Lord answered her, ‘Martha, Martha, you are anxious and troubled about many things, but one thing is necessary. Mary has chosen the good portion,* which will not be taken away from her.”

Confession: “*I will come through this in a ‘superior’ way (superior, not inferior). I claim ‘superior in quality’ health.*”

John 14:27 ESV

“Peace I leave with you; ***my peace I give to you.*** Not as the world gives do I give to you. ***Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid.***” (“Let my perfect peace calm you in every circumstance and give you courage and strength for every challenge.” AMP)

John 16:23–24 KJV

“And in that day ye shall ask me nothing. Verily, verily, I say unto you, ***Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in my name, he will give it you.***
Hitherto have ye asked nothing in my name: ask, and ye shall receive, that your joy may be full.”

John 16:33 KJV

“These things I have spoken unto you, ***that in me ye might have peace.***
In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.” (“*I have told you these things, so that in Me you may have [perfect] peace... be courageous [be confident, be undaunted, be filled with joy].*” AMP)

Confession: “*I will walk in the fullness of God’s joy through this season of my life.*”

Confession: “*I claim perfect health.*”

Acts 10:38 AMP

“How God anointed and consecrated Jesus of Nazareth with the [Holy] Spirit and with strength and ability and power; ***how He went about doing good and, in particular, curing all who were harassed and oppressed by [the power of] the devil, for God was with Him.***”

Confession: “*I resist all harassment and oppression of the devil.*”

Acts 27:23-25 ESV

“For this very night there stood before me an angel of the God to whom I belong and whom I worship, and he said, ***‘Do not be afraid,*** Paul; you must stand before Caesar.
