ASK THE LORD how you can join Him on His Mission to reach your friend.

Remember the Lord has a Plan for the Salvation of every man.

- *1 Timothy 2:3,4 This is good, and pleases God our Savior, who wants all people to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth.*

ASK THE LORD to send believers across their Path with the Gospel.

- *Matthew 9:37,38 Then he said to his disciples, “The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field.*

Example: I ask that You send forth the perfect laborers to share the good news of the gospel in such a way that _____ will listen and understand it.

ASK THE LORD to open their hearts to the Message of the Gospel.

- *Acts 16:14 One of those listening was a woman from the city of Thyatira named Lydia, a dealer in purple cloth. She was a worshiper of God. The Lord opened her heart to respond to Paul’s message.*

ASK THE LORD by His Spirit to draw your loved one to a place of conviction and repentance.

- *John 6:44 No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws them, and I will raise them up at the last day.*

Example: “Therefore, my confession of faith is: ‘God has begun a good work in _____’s life and He will perform it and bring it to full completion until the day of Jesus Christ, in Jesus’ Name.’”

TAKE AUTHORITY over the deception of the devil that is blinding their mind to the gospel and salvation. No one would reject salvation if they could only see just how good the Lord’s plan is for their life.

- *2 Corinthians 4:4 And even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing. The god of this age has blinded the minds of unbelievers, so that they cannot see the light of the gospel that displays the glory of Christ, who is the image of God.*

Example: “You spirit operating in the life of my loved one, blinding _____ to the gospel to keep _____ out of the kingdom of God, I bind you now. I belong to the Lord Jesus Christ. I carry His authority and righteousness, and in His Name I command you to desist in your maneuvers.

STAY ALERT for Opportunities to share. Ask the Lord for boldness to share your faith. Stay off “rabbit trails” and arguments.

- *Ephesians 5:15,16 Be very careful, then, how you live —not as unwise but as wise, making the most of every opportunity, because the days are evil.*

STAY CONNECTED Socially. Position yourself so the Lord can use you. We must “Go into the World” in order to preach the gospel.

- *Acts 8:29 The Spirit told Philip, “Go to that chariot (of the Ethiopian man) and stay near it.*

PRACTICE Acts of Kindness. People don’t care about how much you know until they know how much you care.

- *Luke 10:33 But a Samaritan, as he traveled, came where the man was; and when he saw him, he took pity on him. 34 He went to him and bandaged his wounds, pouring on oil and wine. Then he put the man on his own donkey, brought him to an inn and took care of him. 35 The next day he took out two denarii[c] and gave them to the innkeeper. ‘Look after him,’ he said, ‘and when I return, I will reimburse you for any extra expense you may have.’*

INVITE THEM to Church so they can hear the Gospel.

- *Romans 10:17 Consequently, faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word about Christ*

SHARE your Testimony as the Lord permits. Look for and listen to the spiritual needs of your Friends. Learn to share the gospel in a practical and conversational way. Testimonies can be very powerful. Look for common interest.

- *Mark 5:19 Jesus did not let him, but said, “Go home to your own people and tell them how much the Lord has done for you, and how he has had mercy on you*

MEMORIZE SCRIPTURES that relate to the Plan of Salvation. Be Prepared. Learn Ephesians 2:8,9; Romans 10:9,10; Romans 6:23 (Use a Tract to Present the Gospel i.e. The Four Spiritual Laws (Cru) Steps to Peace with God (Billy Graham)

- *Ephesians 6:17 ... and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace.*

BE SENSITIVE to the Leadership of the Holy Spirit. Know when to speak and when to be quiet. Be sensitive to illustrations and scriptures that the Holy Spirit with bring to your remembrance.

- *John 14:26 But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you*

BEWARE of Procrastination. Don’t put off for tomorrow what you can do today.

- *John 4:35 Don’t you have a saying, ‘It’s still four months until harvest?’ I tell you, open your eyes and look at the fields! They are ripe for harvest.*
