During 2025, we stepped into the vision God had given to us to be **M.O.V.E.D.**



2025 was a year of being **MOVED**.



As we look back on 2025, our hearts are full of gratitude for the ways God truly moved among us—and how His movement invited us to take our next steps. Inspired by the vision “MOVED: I am moved to move,” we watched faith become action as many stepped out boldly to launch a brand-new, life-giving campus in the Greenwood-Loyal area, where an average of 75 people now gather weekly to worship Jesus, grow in faith, and build Christ-centered community. We celebrated new life as 18 people were baptized and five families dedicated their children to the Lord, declaring their trust in God’s promises and their identity made new in Jesus. We saw transformation take root as 67 people completed the Freedom Course, learning to live victoriously in Christ day by day, and as participants in Financial Peace University eliminated \$43,405 of debt, walking into greater financial freedom. Truly, all of creation was waiting—and God was faithful as His people moved forward.

God is on the Move in My Family

“It all started when God spoke to me during a sermon series on raising up spiritual mothers and fathers. As my wife and I prayed regarding our part in that, it became clear that God wanted us to first focus on the closest part of our wingspan: our immediate family. Between my wife and I, there are 7 children, 4 in-laws and 10 grandchildren. A step in the process of reaching my family was enrolling in NRSM. Once I enrolled, my understanding of God's written Word and how to apply it to my daily life, including prayer, quickly began to effect my family.

My oldest son, grandson, and I went on a hunting trip in Colorado where I was enabled by the Holy Spirit to pray for my grandson in a time of need. My son was there and witnessed it. I felt the Holy Spirit flow thru me and heal my grandson immediately. A few months later my son was struggling, he had no where else to look but "up". Since that time, he has been "on fire" and filled with the Holy Spirit - bringing his family along.

My second oldest son attended a service at NRC with his oldest daughter and I this past winter. His daughter attended children's church and received a kid's bible from a pastor. This sparked change in their family. His wife has been hurt spiritually by an atheist family member but has now decided that she wants her children (our grandchildren) to have "hope" of something greater rather than hopelessness. She too has been searching for answers and is visiting churches. My wife and I were able to equip both daughter-in-laws with books and even a study bible as they begin their walk.

Lastly, thru prayer and fasting, I am seeing God move in my daughter's mental illness. We are believing that God is healing her.”

“For many years it has been my hearts desire to minister to others; specially women in jail ministry. After starting the North Ridge School of Ministry, in the fall of 2024, I thought jail ministry would be a possibility five years or so down the road.”

“Well, God was on the move in 2025. He definitely showed me his plans and purposes. In the spring of 2025, I became a volunteer at the Clark County jail doing Bible studies with the women that are incarcerated. I get to share God's Living Word with them, share His love, and forgiveness. It is a blessing to see their joy knowing life is different when you're in relationship with Jesus. God didn't stop there. In late fall, God moved me to become the Program Associate Director in the Recovery Center at Shirleys House of Hope. I get to pour the love of God into women healing from abuse, addiction, and other life issues. God has been on the move in me and through me in 2025!”

Moving Towards Christ-Centered Wholeness

“In 2024, the Freedom Course was a catalyst that led me to diving deeper into my faith. I then gained wisdom and spiritual strength through small groups, daily devotion, and a stronger prayer life. Not only did I grow in spiritual practices, but I grew in understanding my identity as a child of God. This prepared me for the trials I would face in 2025.

My husband, Shannon, had a heart procedure in February which brought complications and continued health issues. It was a confusing and emotional time that changed how we were living our lives. Our plans were surrendered to the day depending on his condition and it forced us to slow down. I continued to step forward in faith and went on a mission trip. Unfortunately, I was the one hospitalized in November due to some parasites that I contracted. During my stay, Shannon had to leave me for a scheduled heart procedure. Our lives were completely in God’s hands.

These challenges could have led to fear, hopelessness and anxiety but through surrendering and continuous devotion, God used it to strengthen and refine us. The power of the Holy Spirit guided us and we experienced His peace in a profound way. As a child of God, I was able to stand in authority of His blessings and promises against every evil thing that came against us. Being surrounded by prayers from our brothers and sisters in Christ gave us hope and empowered us to trust in God’s timing and plan. Rather than asking Him to take it away, we embraced what God desired to do in and through us. In return, God refined our hearts, reshaped our expectations, deepened our trust, and brought us closer together. Shannon and I both came home from the hospital at the end of November, physically healed.

Through these hard experiences I’ve learned that trials can have purpose. God’s power to restore is much greater than any attack we face. God moved me toward Christ-centered wholeness by transforming my mind and actions to experience peace. I now move forward with deeper trust, knowing He will protect and guide me in my purpose for His glory.”


