

We are so thankful for each of you and for the role you play through prayer, encouragement, and support of CAMO Ministry. We wanted to share a brief update on how the Lord worked during this past Christmas season and invite you to continue praying with us for what He is doing among the military community.



This Christmas marked the 12th Annual Christmas Day Pancake Breakfast, and it was a tremendous blessing. On Christmas morning:
• 170 hot meals were prepared and delivered before 7:00 a.m. to service members on duty
• 65 additional service members and their families joined us to enjoy breakfast together

It was a joy to fellowship, encourage, and show the love of Christ during a day that can often feel lonely for those serving. We are deeply grateful to God for His grace and mercy; for you, our prayer partners; our faithful volunteers; the base chapel support staff; and our corporate sponsors.

We were also honored by a **visit from the Joint Base Commander**, accompanied by the Public Affairs Officer (PAO). The PAO recorded a short video of Arlan inviting others to attend breakfast with us. That video was shared on the base social media page by the PAO and received over a thousand reactions, opening many additional opportunities to speak truth into the lives of service members and their families.

Beyond the Christmas outreach, the Lord continues to open doors:

- Arlan, as a Coast Guard Auxiliary Chaplain, **offered the invocation for Wreaths Across America** at the Brigadier General William Doyle Military Cemetery
- **Coast Guard Station Barnegat Light has been added to our regular visitation schedule**, with visits planned every three weeks for consistent relationship-building
