Since my last letter we have returned to the field. We arrived in Port Elizabeth on November 23rd and hit the ground running. It's a great blessing to have a home already setup when you get to the field. We quickly found good vehicles and started assessing the conditions of ministries we had left behind.

There are many positives that happened over the last year and some bad things as well. The Bible college seemed to go on strong. Our student body dropped off some but the grades of many of the students have improved. We can see some of the weaknesses in our training and/or disconnect between class work and putting it into practice in everyday ministry. One of the biggest things that stands out is for our students to have a burden and take ownership in their local church.

As I write this letter we are busy preparing for an open house at the college. We call it "Preview Day" which we stole from our missions agency and the college associated with it. So, this coming Saturday from 10:30-2pm we will be inviting in all the potential students from the sister churches here in Port Elizabeth. We expect about 50 students to come. We will be informing them on how the college works, how they can apply, and what's expected of them. God has supplied some key workers for the college. A man by the name of C.J. Visser recently joined the team. He is a former lawyer that wants to serve the Lord. He has started a law school years ago so he is super helpful in helping us put curriculum together for our classes that we have the rights to. He is also going to help us get the college to where we can make it available for distant study for other churches in South Africa and the world for that matter. His son is a software engineer, Ricco, and he is currently helping us to build a new website as our old one is defunct and we have been unable to get it right. We believe these are answers to prayers and hope they will lead to furthering the gospel.

Right now we are back at Kuyga Baptist Church. We definitely had some unexpected challenges to fix when we got back but overall we can praise the LORD that the church did continue in our absence with young leadership. They did continue to preach the gospel and reach the lost souls so those are big wins! Since we got back we have seen a number of men either return or start visiting the church. Just this past Sunday we had 4 souls ask Christ to save them and plan to have a baptismal service this coming Sunday so God has been very good to us.
