Admissions

Requirements

- Students must be fully potty-trained.
- Students applying for the 3-year-old program must be 3 years old by December 1st.

Procedure

- All students are required to go through the application process before admission. Once the application is received in its entirety and preliminary acceptance is given, a Board member may contact the family for an interview before final approval. Applications are available on the website <https://ccohv.org/calvary-chapel-academy>. Applications will be reviewed strictly on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Steps:

 2. The Board will review the application.
 3. An interview with an administrator may be scheduled.
 4. A welcome packet or non-acceptance letter will be sent.

Payment due dates

Twenty percent (20%) of the annual tuition is due on September 1. The remainder owed will be billed in equal monthly installments from October through June and is due on the first of each month. Automatic electronic payments are preferred and may be set up during the enrollment process.

- For example, if you pay the 5-full-day Calvary Chapel attendee rate, \$1,080 is due on or before September 1. The remaining \$4,320 is divided over the next nine months (\$480/mo) and billed October 1-June 1.

Mid-year entry and mid-year withdrawals

- Tuition will be prorated monthly for students entering or exiting during the school year.
- If a student enters before the 15th of the month, tuition is owed for the entirety of the month. If a student enters after the 15th of the month, tuition is not owed for the month the student enrolled.
- If a student withdraws before the 15th of the month, tuition is not owed that month. If a student withdraws after the 15th of the month, tuition for the month of withdrawal is owed.

Late fees

- There will be a \$50 late fee for all tuition payments more than 3 days late.

- There will be a late pickup fee of \$20 if a student is picked up more than 15 minutes late without notice.

Tuition will not be prorated or adjusted due to infrequent attendance, inclement weather, or other emergency closings.

Discounts/Scholarships

- To receive the Calvary Rate, the parent and child must regularly attend CCHV in person for a minimum of 1 year and tithe.
- If multiple children of the same household are attending, the family will receive a 20% discount on the total tuition.
- Tuition may be paid in full on or before September 1. In this case, a 5% discount will be applied prior to payment.
- All scholarships and discounts are subject to school board approval.
