Exodus 34:6-7

Introduction

1. The Precursor to God’s Self-Revelation (Ex. 33:12-34:5)

A. Moses’ three requests (33:12-23)

- i. Go with me/teach me your ways (vv. 12-13)
- ii. If you don’t go with us, don’t send us (v. 15)
- iii. Show me your glory (v. 18)

B. Restoration of the covenant (34:1-5)

- i. New tablets (v. 1)
- ii. God’s instructions (vv. 2-3)
- iii. Moses ascends, God descends (vv. 4-5)

2. The Self-Revelation of God (Ex. 34:6-7)

A. God proclaims His name (v. 6)

B. The Lord, The Lord (v. 6; Ex. 3:15; 20:2)

3. The God of Compassion (34:6)

A. Compassion defined

- i. Derived from the word for “womb”
- ii. Emotion (Gen. 43:30; 1 Kings 3:26; Ps. 103:13; Is. 49:15-16)
- iii. Action/forgiveness (Mic. 7:19; Ps. 51:1; Ps. 78:36-38)

B. Compassion embodied: Jesus (Col. 1:19)

- i. Compassion in action (Matt. 20:34; 15:32)
- ii. Meeting physical and spiritual needs (Matt. 9:35-38; Jon. 4:1-3)
- iii. The ultimate showing of compassion (1 Pet. 3:18)

C. Compassion applied: embrace and extend

- i. Share the gospel
- ii. Care for and meet needs of the vulnerable
- iii. Forgive (Eph. 4:32)
