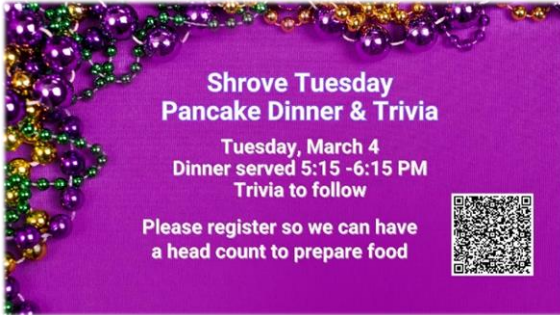
3/4 5:15 – 7:15 PM Shrove Tuesday Pancake Dinner
