1. What was most revealing or most important to you in the message?
2. Our care for others always comes first from God's care for us. *1 John 4:19* says, "*We love Him because He first loved us*" and *Romans 5:8* says, "*God demonstrated His love for us in the while we were sinners He died for us.*" Without God's love there would be no love. Do you agree or disagree? God always makes the first move. Talk about one of these two verses above and why the truth is so meaningful to us. Why doesn't God make us get our act together before He extends to us. Share some examples of people in the Bible where He did that (Zaccheus, demoniac, lepers, etc). What happened to their lives?
3. As we experience His care, what should that do in us? How is the church called to be Christ's hands and heart. Name a person in your life that loved you when you were unlovely. What action did they take to make a difference? (A parent, teacher, guardian, pastor, coach are examples) What word or action did they offer toward you. How did it change your situation or your life? Talk about a believer who helped bring you to Christ or showed Christ's love.
4. Can you recall a time where you took that step for another? Was it easy or difficult? Talk about the obstacles. Did you see a change in them or are they still relatively the same? What does it mean that we are His ambassadors, light, and reconcilers to the world? What most helps you to do this? What limits you the most?
5. Talk about someone that you need to extend to in a special way soon? What might be going on in his or her life? Think about their past or struggles that make them harder to love at times. What would Christ speak to you about this person?
