

2023 OSF Giving Campaign and Charity Offering

Submission Rules for the Designated Charity

OHSOFREE Ministries, Inc established the **CEASE THE HURT** mission to support our community by serving women who need mental, physical, and spiritual support.

The Charity Offering portion of our **2023 OSF Giving Campaign and Charity Offering** will fall under our **CEASE THE HURT** mission offshoot.

As part of our fundraising efforts, we will raise funds to help another charity by giving 10% of the donations raised during the Campaign designated times to the charity chosen by our OSF Members.

Our purpose is to allow various groups to be recognized for their hard work and dedication to our community.

Procedure for submission

- Members of the OSF community submit charities that serve women to the OSF Board of Directors. The Board of Directors will vote on three charities from the OSF Member submissions that adhere to the guidelines.
- The OSF Facebook group members vote for their favorite women's charity.
- The OSF Board of Directors announces the winning charity, and 10% of the total **OSF Giving Campaign and Charity Offering** funds raised during the fundraising period are forwarded to the chosen charity.

Submission criteria

- Your charity submission must be a non-political, women's charitable organization with a qualifying IRS 501c3 designation to be eligible to participate in our Charity Offering event.
- An OSF Facebook member must submit the nomination form for the charity during the nomination period.
- The three charities or organizations selected must provide proof of 501c3 charity status. The charity staff member must email all supporting documentation and a video of their charity to an OSF Director to be approved before the start of the voting period.

- Charity nominations are open on the **15th day of January 2023 and close on the 31st day of January.**
- The OSF Board of Directors will vote to nominate three submissions on **Monday, February 13, 2023.**
- The OSF Board of Directors will present the nominated submissions to the OSF Facebook Group during the OSF Giving Campaign and Charity Offering and voting period of **March 15, 2023, and close on March 29, 2023.**
- Charities are only eligible for submission once every five years and must be submitted by a verified member of the OSF Ministries community.
- OSF retains the right to 'approve' or 'disapprove' any displays, text, writing, logos, or references to the charity to be presented for support or placement on the OSF Facebook group or app.
- OSF reserves the right to change or cancel this program at anytime.

Award Determination:

- The winner is the women's charity that receives the most votes in the OSF Facebook group during the voting period.
- The OSF Board of Directors approves the final winner within 72 hours of the contest's end.
- Once votes are tallied, the OSF Board of Directors will notify the winner and post the winner on the FB Group page on **March 31, 2023.** The Board of Directors then determines the date and time of the offering distribution.
- The winning organization receives the gift offering within 5-10 business days after closing the Giving Campaign.
