1. Bible (Physical, not phone app)

Rules and Expectations

Rules & Expectations

- All adult leaders have the same authority as any leader.
- Clean up after yourselves.
- Conduct yourself in a Christ-like manner. (Language and actions)
- No firearms, tobacco, or illegal substances will be allowed.
- Be on time for everything.
- No boys are allowed in the girl's cabins, and vice versa.



- Unless you have been instructed, please do not enter another group's cabins or touch their belongings.
- Cell phones will only be allowed at specific times each day.
- Dress attire must be appropriate for godly men and women. This includes swimwear. No bikinis or Speedos.
- No one is allowed to go off on their own. Buddy system at all times.
- Students are expected to help with any setup and clean up.
- Follow the scheduled times and make sure you adhere to them, especially regarding being in your cabins and "lights out." No one is allowed out of their rooms after "lights out" unless it's an emergency.
- Wear nicer dress attire for evening worship gatherings. No swimsuits.
