Second, the Bible is clear that Christians are never under the ruling authority of Satan. The devil can never take authority over a Christian.

Third, the devil can influence a Christian. We are in spiritual warfare against an enemy who seeks to steal and kill and destroy (John 10:10). Even Jesus was attacked by the demons and Satan in this way (Matt 4: 1-11; Luke 4: 1-13)

As Christians, we are responsible and empowered by God to r_____ Satan and his demons. If we do resist, we need not suffer under the influence of demons, and we can live daily in the victory Christ has won for us.
