It's Wedding Season!

It's currently the end of May as I'm writing this, and I've been a guest at two weddings already. In all the excitement of wedding planning, there's usually some advice coming from friends and family that have years of marriage under their belt. My husband and I will be married eight years this August; this is our advice to the newly engaged and newly married.

Keep God First! This is one you will hear a lot, especially within the church. It doesn't often come with an explanation though. Note that when someone says to keep God first in your marriage, it is impossible to do so without God being first in your life. There is no way to have God first in only one area of your life. Proverbs 3:5-6 tells us to trust in the Lord with ALL your heart and to seek His will in ALL you do. God is not asking for a part of your life (i.e., just your marriage), He wants all of it; then He will show you which path to take. Matthew 22:37 says loving God with ALL our heart, soul, and mind is the first and greatest commandment, even above loving/ respecting your spouse. All else will come within keeping God first.

Decide early to work through all things together. The divorce rate in the church should be significantly lower than our secular counterparts, sadly it is not. Matthew 19:6 says that we should let no one separate what God has joined together. Giving a judge the authority to dissolve a marriage is taking the authority to heal any broken situation in a marriage out of God's hands and attempting to put the authority into man's hands. We then let the judge separate what God put together. Make the decision early that Matthew 19:6 will hold true in your marriage no matter what. Ecclesiastes 4:9-12 outlines the benefits of partnership. Working together through hardships is a part of God's design for the church and marriage. Decide early to be a good partner.

Remember, your spouse is a sinner saved by grace just like you. We generally find it easier to give ourselves more grace for our mistakes than we give to those around us. It is especially important to approach your spouse with a heart of grace because you encounter your spouse most frequently. Therefore, you have an opportunity to extend grace to someone every day. Ephesians 2:8-9 reminds us that we did not save ourselves by our own great works, so we can't boast about how great we are. Only by God's grace were we saved through faith in Jesus. We have done nothing to be exalted above our spouse or anyone else. Ephesians 4:2-3 tells us that as Christians we should be humble and patient and in doing so, we create peace. The chapter ends with the command to "be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you". Your spouse will miss the mark, we all do at some point. In that moment, what will matter most is how you respond.

If you know someone getting married this season, share this advice. If you are getting married this season, we pray that the Lord will soften your heart to these words and the Holy Spirit will remind you of these verses when you need them the most.
