This 5-day devotional guide is based on Deuteronomy 6:4-9 and other key passages in Deuteronomy. It will help you prepare your heart for the upcoming Sunday sermon, "A New Generation," in the preaching series, "A Covenant with God." It may also be used as a guide for family devotions and is for the week ending Saturday, February 7, 2026.

Monday

Scripture: Deuteronomy 6:4-5

Questions for Reflection

- What does the phrase "Hear, O Israel" mean?
- What does it mean that "The Lord our God, the Lord is one"?
- Why is loving God with all your heart, soul, and strength so important?
- How can you show love for God in your daily life?

Questions for Children

- Who should we love most?
- How can you show love to God today?

Prayer Prompt

Lord, You alone are God, and You deserve all my love. Help me to love You with all my heart, soul, and strength

today. Teach me to put You first in every thought and action. Amen.

Tuesday

Scripture: Deuteronomy 6:6-9

Questions for Reflection

- What did God tell the people to do with His commands?
- Why is it important to talk about God's Word at home and with your family?
- How can you make God's Word part of your home and family life?
- What is one way you can talk about God today?

Questions for Children

- Where should we keep God's words?
- Who can you tell about God today?

Prayer Prompt

Father, thank You for giving me Your Word. Help me to treasure it in my heart and talk about it with my family. Show me ways to make Your truth part of my home and daily life. Amen.

Wednesday

Scripture: Deuteronomy 8:1-10

Questions for Reflection

- Why did God remind Israel about their time in the wilderness?
- What does this passage teach about remembering God's blessings?

- How can you thank God for what He has given you?
- What is one blessing you can praise God for today?

Questions for Children

- Who gave the people food in the wilderness?
- What good things has God given you?

Prayer Prompt

Lord, I remember Your goodness and provision. Thank You for every blessing You have given me. Keep me humble and grateful, and help me to praise You for all You have done. Amen.

Thursday

Scripture: Deuteronomy 11:18-21

Questions for Reflection

- What did God say to do with His words?
- Why does God want His Word to be part of everyday life?
- How can you keep God's Word close to your heart?
- What is one way you can remind yourself of God's truth today?

Questions for Children

- Where should we keep God's words?
- Why do we talk about God at home?

Prayer Prompt

God, write Your words on my heart and mind. Help me to live by Your truth and share it with those around me. May my home reflect Your presence every day. Amen.

Friday

Scripture: Deuteronomy 30:15-20

Questions for Reflection

- What choice did God give His people in this passage?
- Why is choosing life and obedience so important?
- How does this passage challenge you to follow God fully?
- What is one decision you can make today to obey God?

Questions for Children

- What two choices did God give the people?
- Which choice should we make?

Prayer Prompt

Lord, today I choose life by following You. Give me strength to obey Your commands and turn away from anything that leads to death. Help me to walk closely with You. Amen.
