This 5-day devotional guide is based on Hosea 6:1-11 and will help you prepare your heart for the upcoming Sunday sermon, "God's Call to Repentance," in the preaching series, "Relentless Love." It may also be used as a guide for family devotions and is for the week ending Saturday, February 28, 2026.

Monday

Scripture: Hosea 6:1-3

Questions for Reflection

- What invitation does God give His people?
- What promises come with returning to God?
- What does this teach us about God's healing and restoration?
- When have you experienced God's restoring grace?

Questions for Children

- What does God want His people to do?
- What will God do when they return?

Prayer Prompt

Lord, thank You for inviting us back when we wander. Heal our hearts and make us whole. Amen.

Tuesday

Scripture: Hosea 6:4-6

Questions for Reflection

- How does God describe Israel's love?
- What does God desire more than sacrifices?
- What does this teach us about true worship?
- How can you show steadfast love to God today?

Questions for Children

- Was Israel's love strong or weak?
- What does God want more than gifts?

Prayer Prompt

Father, help us love You with all our hearts. Teach us to know You and not just go through motions. Amen.

Wednesday

Scripture: Hosea 6:7-9

Questions for Reflection

- What sins are mentioned here?
- How does this show breaking covenant with God?
- What does this teach us about the seriousness of sin?
- What steps can you take to stay faithful to God?

Questions for Children

- Did the people obey God's covenant?
- Why is it important to keep promises?

Prayer Prompt

Lord, keep us from breaking Your covenant. Help us walk in Your ways every day. Amen.

Thursday

Scripture: Hosea 6:10-11

Questions for Reflection

- What does God see in Israel and Judah?
- How does God respond to their sin?
- What does this teach us about God's justice and mercy?
- How can you repent and seek God's mercy today?

Questions for Children

- What did God see in the land?
- What does God want His people to do?

Prayer Prompt

Father, thank You for Your mercy. Help us turn from sin and live in Your love. Amen.

Friday

Scripture: Hosea 6:11

Questions for Reflection

- What hope does God give in this verse?
- How does this show God's plan to restore His people?
- What does this teach us about God's faithfulness?

- How does this hope encourage you today?

Questions for Children

- What will God give His people?
- Why is that good news?

Prayer Prompt

Lord, thank You for the hope of restoration. Help us trust in Your promises and live for You. Amen.
