



Does G-D really care about...?

READ: Bereshit 3:1 **1**But the serpent was shrewder than any animal of the field that Adonai Elohim made. So it said to the woman, "Did God really say, "...

It is has been the argument of people throughout the centuries, and the original argument of the first deceiver (liar) and enemy of mankind; this idea that G-D "might not have said..." or G-D "didn't really mean..." something that HE has explicitly said in HIS word. One of the hardest part of being a believer is listening to deceived people either knowingly or innocently repeating the original lie of hasatan.

Does G-D really care if we follow his commands?

READ: Jeremiah 34:8-22

What was G-D's response when HIS people pretended, or almost did the thing He commanded, and then broke the covenant they made?

Does G-D really care how we treat others?

READ: Shemot 21:1-24:18

Does he care about individual rights to property? To freedom? To how we care for other peoples things? How we celebrate? What we celebrate? Who we worship? Where we live (in regard to who influences us)?

Does G-D really care if we make our beds?

READ: Matthew 15:1-9

Do your parents care if you make your bed, or if your room is clean? G-D tells us that we MUST honor our parents, and that means obeying them, and doing things they care about.

Something to think about:

Some people have this idea of G-D in which He sets the world in motion, and then stands at a distance to watch. This is NOT the G-D that we have in the Bible. Our G-D is

intimately interested in the everyday goings on of our lives, the instructions He gives shows very clearly that HE cares about even the smallest details. In Luke 12:6-7 HE tells us: "6" Aren't five sparrows being sold for two pennies? Yet not one of them is forgotten before God.

7Indeed, even the hairs of your head are all numbered. So do not fear; you are more valuable than many sparrows." Each one of our hairs is numbered and matters to G-D! Isn't this amazing?
