PACKING SUGGESTIONS



- ___ Passport
- ___ You'll need a paper copy of the Bible
- ___ Your personal meds and prescriptions.
- ___ Whatever it takes to get you ready.
- ___ Baby/Body wipes are good for freshening up.
- ___ Hand sanitizer
- ___ Did we mention your passport?
- ___ Water Bottle Container (Hydration is key. Bring as large as you would like)
- ___ Please pack bigger bottles of lotions, shampoos, etc in your checked luggage. You may want to put these items in a ziploc bag to keep them from leaking during the pressures of the flight.
- ___ You may want to bring a small clip on fan for your bed and extension cord. We will have American style electrical outlets. No need for power adapters.
- ___ Hats
- ___ Project Needs: Painting and construction clothes and gloves. Everyone will be doing some sort of project on Saturday.
- ___ Sunscreen

You do not need bedding or towels since they are provided by the hotel.

Clothing

- ___ Your FBC trip shirts
- ___ We have learned that its almost necessary to plan for 2 sets of clothes per day.
- ___ Climate is hot! Plan accordingly.
- ___ Shorts and t-shirts are fine. Shorts must come to just above the knee and shirts cannot be cutoff. No tank-tops.
- ___ For Worship Service: Casual. No shorts. Khakis and capris are fine. Dresses are not necessary but you can wear them if you'd like.
- ___ Work clothes that you don't mind getting dirty or painted.
- ___ Shoes that would work well for VBS and work projects. Closed toed shoes are suggested.
- ___ Tennis shoes and flip flops. You may want to bring a pair of shoes to donate.
- ___ Swimwear for the pool if you'd like.

Considerations for Traveling

- Smile! Our attitude will take us a long way!
- 360 degree rolling luggage will be your friend!
- Neck pillow (optional but nice)
- Passport! Figure out a way to keep your passport, money, and personal items safe. A waist belt, fanny pack, backpack, etc will work.
- Bring a portable battery for phones and don't forget your charging cords. Some planes have places to plug in your devices. Most are USB.
- Backpack for all your carry around stuff during the day and at VBS and work projects.
- Each passenger flying with DELTA can bring 1 carry-on bag and 1 personal item free of charge (such as a purse, laptop bag or item of similar size that will fit underneath the seat in front of you). If you plan to bring roll-aboard luggage or a large bag to store in the overhead bin, you can find size information below.
- Carry-on luggage. Check the size of your carryon. Individual length, width and height measurements may not exceed 22" x 14" x 9" Don't overpack. They won't fit in the overhead. It's a good idea to put a couple of changes of clothes in your backpack or carry-on.
- Checked luggage cannot be over 50 pounds. Baggage size must not exceed 62 inches (158 cm) when you total LENGTH + WIDTH + HEIGHT. (Don't get too overwhelmed by this. If you have bought a suitcase in the last 10 years, you should be good.)
- Put copies of your passport in each bag.
- Shoes that work well for flight. Which means, easy off and on as we go through TSA.
- 3.1.1. quart bag for your travel liquids.
- We will pack our VBS and work supplies into extra bags. Some of you will be assigned a bag to check at the airport. The trip budget will pay for our supply bags.
- Notify your bank credit/debit card of your travel plans. They will lock you up if you don't!
- Check with your cellphone provider about international calls and texting.

Money Needs:

- MEALS: Most of your meals are paid for. You will need money for airport meals and possibly your meal on our excursion day. There may be opportunities to grab local snacks too
- SHOPPING: We will stop for souvenirs and other items on our excursion day. You can shop at the airport but it cost considerably more.
- Checked luggage fee is \$35 each way. You will need to pay for this with a debit/credit card. NO CASH IS ACCEPTED.
