
KC Impact Team Approach

- Scale outreach capacity over time

Why It Matters

- Service opens doors for prayer and connection
- Outreach strengthens church unity and purpose

Phase 1: Immediate Outreach



Community Partnership

Mission Mansfield Center

- Provides food, clothing, medical care, financial assistance, and crisis support to families in Mansfield
- Inspires human dignity through compassion and support for neighbors in need
- Allows us to directly serve struggling families in our own community

Taste Project (Arlington)

- Pay-what-you-can restaurant ensuring access to healthy meals
- Serves with dignity — guests contribute what they are able
- Opportunity for volunteer service and relationship building

Under the Bridge (Fort Worth)

- Direct outreach to individuals experiencing homelessness
- Provides food, hygiene supplies, prayer, and encouragement
- Taking the Gospel outside the four walls in practical ways
