Icebreaker:

When you were in school, did you like to sit in the front of the class or the back (or the middle...I guess!)? Why?

How do you prefer to receive hard or difficult news? Why?

Discussion Questions:

1. Read Isaiah 6:1-13 together.

2. As you picture the scene, which emotions do you think Isaiah was feeling? What may his thoughts have been?

How is the reader/listener supposed to think and feel?

3. One of the most difficult challenges in life is to find one's purpose. How have you gone about finding your purpose in life?

Where do you find meaning: job, faith, family, home, etc.?

How do these different areas of life coalesce in your overall life purpose?

4. There is a glimpse of hope at the end of our passage where Isaiah reminds the listener of the promise of God (Isaiah 6:13; Genesis 15:5-6). What are the promises of God to which you cling during hard times?

In what ways do they encourage you to have hope?

5. Do you find yourself willing and eager to share the good news of Jesus Christ? Why or why not?

6. It can be difficult to share the good news of Jesus when we don't know where or how to start. Do you have people in your life who God is calling you to share Jesus with? How do you begin that process? How can your small group support you in this endeavor?
