Connecting Scriptures

Psalm 63:1–8 – Seeking God early

Matthew 9:36–38 – Compassion for the crowds

Reflection Questions

- What does my prayer life reveal about my priorities?
- Where is Jesus inviting me to move from the crowd into calling?
