

## Community Church Scholarship Application

### Description of Available Scholarships

Annual Scholarships are offered to students as a tangible expression of love and support on behalf of the congregation of Community Church of Casselberry. They are available to undergraduate and graduate students at colleges, universities, or vocational schools. A student who has been awarded a scholarship may reapply in subsequent years. Scholarships will be awarded with consideration both to the amount of money available, the need, and the circumstances of each applicant.

### Eligibility

1. Be a member of Community for at least one year as of April 10th of the year in which you are applying
2. Be a resident of Florida
3. Be accepted in a course of study at a college, university, or vocational school
4. Have been active in ministry at Community Church -continue to attend and be active at Community Church if not going away to school
5. Must be willing to be interviewed by the Scholarship Committee

### How to apply:

1. Go online at [www.casselberrychurch.org/scholarshipapplication](http://www.casselberrychurch.org/scholarshipapplication) or pick up an application from the Receptionist desk at the church office.
2. Complete the application (either legibly handwritten or using the PDF).
3. Submit a current official transcript (high school seniors) or a printed unofficial transcript with grades (college/university students). All applicants must have a minimum 2.0 cumulative G.P.A.
4. Submit two letters of recommendation/reference. At least one must be from a current **OR** former school staff person (instructor, counselor, coach, professor, etc.) on letterhead, **if possible**, from the school itself (high school, college, university or vocational school). The letter of recommendation from a school staff person should be physically mailed **OR** emailed to the church office at [info@casselberrychurch.org](mailto:info@casselberrychurch.org): Attn Scholarship Committee (first time applicants only). Both letters must be written in the current school year.
5. Submit a letter or email copy of your acceptance from the school you plan to attend (First year applicants only).
6. First time applicants must submit a current picture.
7. Your **COMPLETE** package (all necessary documents listed above) must be mailed to Attn: Scholarship Committee, Community Church, 321 Piney Ridge Rd, Casselberry, FL 32707, OR scanned and emailed to [info@casselberrychurch.org](mailto:info@casselberrychurch.org).
8. **Applications must be received on or before April 10th - NO EXCEPTIONS.** All required documents **MUST** be submitted when applying. No documents can be added after submission, and your application will not be considered unless **ALL** of the above have been completed.
9. All applicants must fill out the same application whether they are new applicants or repeat applicants.
