

# LIFE

People helping people live out the unexpected love of Jesus every day.

This is an abridged version of a devotional that I shared at Prayer Meeting a few weeks ago:

There is a shortened form of the formal name of God, YHWH. We generally pronounce this as "Yahweh," but Latinization and then importing into English produced the name "Jehovah." This shortened version of Jehovah is *Jah* (pronounced "yah"). Along with *Jehovah/Yahweh*, this is normally translated in our English Bibles with the small caps "LORD."

*Jah* literally means "He is," or "I AM," corresponding to the full meaning of Jehovah: "I AM THAT I AM." The very first use of *Jah* is in the Song of Moses, Exodus 15:2:

"The LORD (*Jah*) is my strength and my song; he has become my salvation. This is my God, and I will praise him, my father's God, and I will exalt him."

Sometimes *Jah* is even used with *Jehovah* to strengthen the honor given to God:

"Trust in the LORD (*Jehovah*) forever, because in the LORD (*Jah*), the LORD (*Jehovah*) himself, is an everlasting rock!" Isaiah 26:4

We see the connection to this name as "LORD" in several places where it is included (sometimes hidden) in compound words, especially names:  
Adonijah: *Jah* is Lord (notice "Adonai" at the beginning)  
Zechariah: *Jah* remembers


The statements "He is" or "I AM" do not merely speak to the basic truth of God's existence. Instead, they are statements of *eternal fact*. We could say that *Jah* means "The self-existent One." He has always existed, since before time began. Prior to His creating everything, He was all that existed.

This name comes down to the concept of *necessity*. I don't mean that the name is necessary. I mean that without God's existence, nothing else could exist. So God is *necessary*, and everything else is *contingent*. He is also necessarily *transcendent*: He exists outside of the bounds of this universe, and He holds the universe, rather than the universe holding Him (God making a universe from within said universe before that universe existed is nonsensical). The divine name *Jah*—the self-existent One—captures the fact of God's eternal reality well! Hallelujah! (literally: "Praise be to *Jah*!")
