Communities

February 17-23

February 17 This first day of Ramadan, morale will be high and the community will be buzzing with energy. *Pray for Muslims across the region to experience the Light of the World this Ramadan.*

February 18 Evening prayers are a community event. Often people will pray the last prayer of the day at the mosque together, eat a meal and pray the extra prayers Ramadan provides. *Pray for whole communities to be transformed by the Gospel, that churches would be planted!*

February 19 Many of the daily rhythms of a community change during fasting month. The day begins slower, bazaars spring up selling food, people stay up well into the night gathering together. *Pray for the outreach efforts going on as believers join Muslim friends in breaking fast together.*

February 20 Men will head to the mosque today to hear a sermon and perform their prayers together as a community. *Pray for a spiritual longing to well up in the hearts of these men. They are often the spiritual leaders and carry great influence. Pray for many of them to receive salvation through Christ.*

February 21 Shared holidays are never easy. This is the first weekend of Ramadan but also the first weekend of Chinese New Year. *Pray for peace and unity in communities as they share a holiday.*

February 22 Tragedy plagues all communities, but motor related accidents are prevalent given the number of motorcycles and vehicles on the road. *Pray for safe passage through the streets as motorists and pedestrians hurry to gather last minute supplies for the week ahead.*

February 23 As schools resume this Monday morning, students and teachers alike will sit in stifling hot classrooms without food or water. *Pray for many teachers and administrators to follow Jesus, bringing change to the culture of schools. Pray too for their physical bodies to be strong in the heat.*



Families

February 24-March 2

February 24 Families are the heartbeat of a community. *Pray today for families across the region to pause and pursue time together, whether a meal to break fast or something as simple as a shared cup of tea around the table.*

February 25 As is often the case, when a mother comes to Christ, the direction of her children changes course towards Him too. *Pray for mothers to have access to a clear Gospel presentation and that they would understand and respond to God's call through Christ.*

February 26 Brokenness ravages families across the region. Infidelity, debt and quick money schemes, abuse. *Pray for chains of bondage to be broken that families would be restored by God's grace and healing would be found.*

February 27 Fathers carry the spiritual responsibility of taking sons to the mosque to pray on Fridays. *As many fathers and sons go to say prayers today, pray for their hearts to be gripped by the Holy Spirit that they would be saved.*

February 28 Outreach to whole families is ongoing. Giving a family unit an opportunity to hear and respond to the Gospel gives those interested in believing a head start on forming a church. *Pray for whole families to hear and believe!*

March 1 Once someone chooses to follow Christ, finding a Christian spouse is a significant challenge. Issues of legally marrying, registering children, buying property, and more all come to light. *Pray over BMBs faced with these challenges that they would be filled with wisdom from above.*

March 2 As children grow and leave the villages to study, their culture changes and takes a new form. Upon returning to their village, they find themselves at odds with the expectations they previously filled with ease. *Pray for peace as these tensions show themselves in villages across the area as many return home for a visit.*



Churches
March 3-9

March 3 Praise God that more churches across the region are choosing to share the Gospel with ALL PEOPLES! *Pray and ask the Lord for even greater participation from churches across the region.*

March 4 As churches grow and mature in health, a natural next step includes welcoming BMBs (Believers from a Muslim Background) in to worship as part of the family. *Pray for the health of the Church that many more would become open to receiving BMBs.*

March 5 The Lord is calling people to Himself and they are responding! But much fear of being reported by family or persecution from the government is real. *Pray for BMBs to join together as Church in deep, meaningful community.*

March 6 Churches utilize fasting month as a springboard into outreach. Small groups or prayer groups will go out seeking opportunities to share. *As church members go out to break fast with their Muslim neighbors, pray for authentic relationships to be built that would allow Gospel flow.*

March 7 As leaders age and retire, new leaders come along. As new churches are planted, fresh DNA is written into the church. *Pray for strong, young, godly leaders to be raised up with a heart for reaching the unreached Muslims around them so the next generation of churches could carry out this task.*

March 8 As churches meet across the region today, may they become aware of the missing people groups not yet represented in their congregations. *Pray that the Lord would break their hearts for the lost and that evangelism would be the next step for many believers.*

March 9

This Monday morning people will be returning to the office. And yet, for many, their faith remains hidden for no one to see. *Pray that today would be different, and believers would feel emboldened to share their faith with their Muslim coworkers!*



Salvations

March 10-19

Pray the following verses over the Muslims across our region, that they might understand the truths and come to know Christ.

March 10 “And there is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.” Acts 4:12

March 11 For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek; for the same Lord is Lord of all, bestowing his riches on all who call on him. For “everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.” Romans 10:13

March 12 Jesus said to him, “I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.” John 14:6

March 13 “Behold, God is my salvation; I will trust, and will not be afraid; for the Lord God is my strength and my song, and he has become my salvation.”
Isaiah 12:2

March 14 “because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.”
Romans 10:9

March 15 And they said, “Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household.” Romans 16:31

March 16 “For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God,” Ephesians 2:8

March 17 We trust God’s Word will not return void. Praise God for this truth. Pray for many to receive dreams and visions solidifying the truths they’ve heard this Ramadan.

March 18 This month countless spiritual conversations will have transpired. Pray for follow-up meetings to be arranged and for the Holy Spirit to remove the veil that covers the hearts of Muslims across the region.

March 19 This last day of Ramadan, praise God for the many answered prayers this season. He will do abundantly more than we could ask or imagine. He is able!
